3 Reminders:



COVID-19 prevention is still important after you are vaccinated. We all need to do our part until most of our community has been vaccinated and COVID-19 rates are low. **Continue the 3 Ws:** **W**ear a mask, **W**atch your distance and **W**ash hands frequently.



The vaccine is 95% effective at preventing COVID-19 only after the second dose. Make a note:
