MANDATORY COLOR OF TRAUMA VIRTUAL PRESENTATION FOR ALL STUDENTS On March 11th, all students will be participating in a mandatory virtual assembly "The Color of Trauma" presented by Charde Hollins and Brittany Works. Throughout the course of this incredible assembly, students will further learn and develop the vocabulary for discussing race, skin color, beauty, and history. Our expert presenters will define equality and equity and explore their differences.

Students will learn how to take action and apply knowledge and understanding to consider their roles as activists in their school, home, and community. They will identify how activism and change are important to communities, discuss a variety of characteristics and what action makes someone a leader.

Students will understand the power of allies and the importance of working well together by learning to further incorporate concepts into everyday routines to continuously create safe spaces for racial equality and inclusion, how they can advocate for themselves and others when injustice occurs, and to recognize, respond, and prevent bias.

Finally, our presenters will work to instill self-empowerment and reflection within our school community of learners. By becoming aware that positive talk influences mood, behavior, and relations, students understand their ability to learn from adversity and become stronger, wiser individuals.
