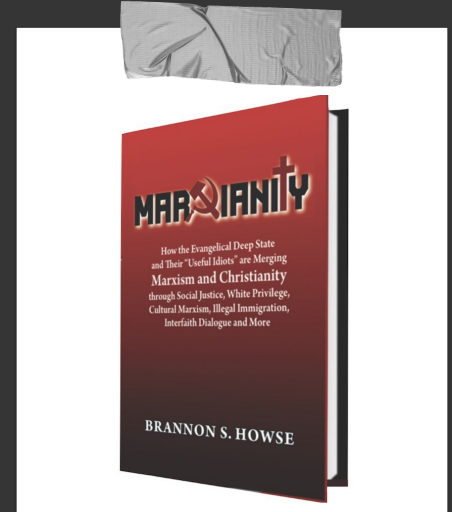

The key to this information operation is to hide Marxist ideologies under masking terms that are given credibility through the use of twisted scriptures as well as revisionist history and the elimination of truth, reason, logic, and context. They must also enlist religious useful idiots and compromised “bridgers” that aid in merging the religious left and the religious right.

By confronting these tactics, those who stand firm on the Word of God and refuse to compromise will be set up for ridicule and persecution. They’ll be labeled haters, intolerant, bigots, divisive, mean-spirited, and unloving by those outside of evangelicalism, as well as the evangelical deep state.

The proponents of Marxianity are co-opting Christianity and enlisting useful “idiots” to turn churches into community organizations for social justice, pastors into community organizers, the Great Commission into the “Great Group Consensus” and recast the Biblical Jesus into a social justice warrior.

Acts 20 and Jude 3 warn of the men that make up the evangelical deep state. Their agenda is fueled by redefining a Biblical gospel away from individual salvation through faith and repentance to a collective salvation that calls for the “Marxians” of the world to unite to heal the wrongs and to create a “just” society that eliminates poverty and injustice and creates the kingdom of God on earth through collective salvation.

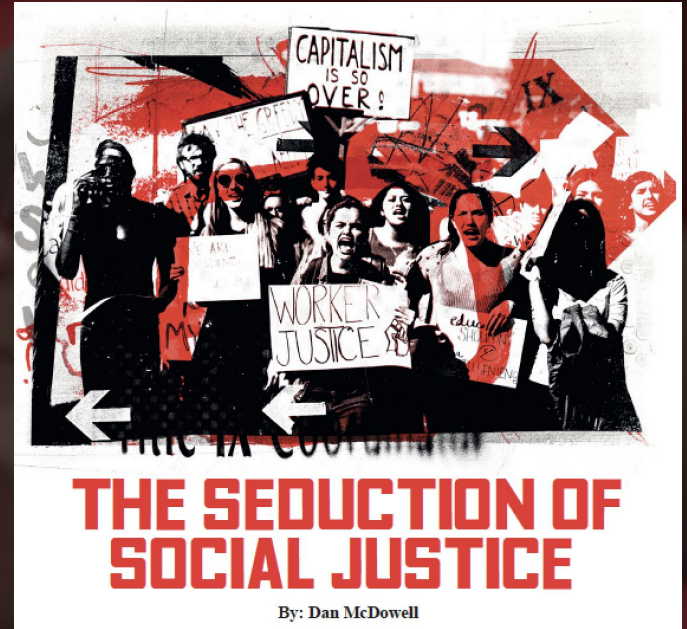

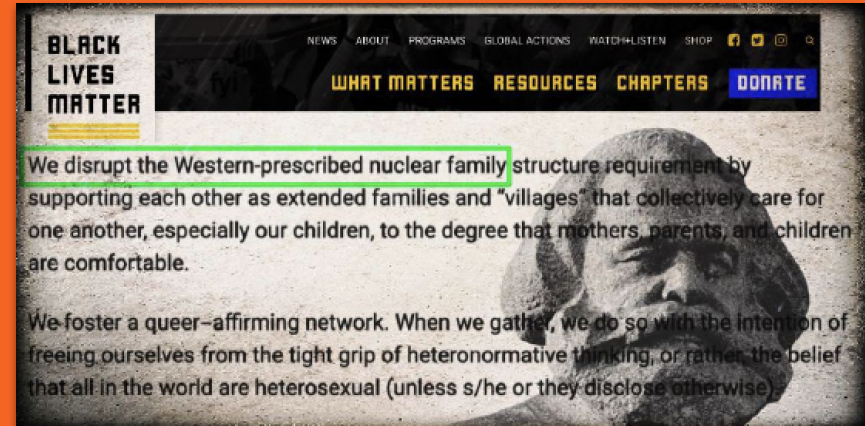


Critical Theory

4-Stage Approach

1. Identify the disadvantaged group or groups.
2. Assess the inequality of outcomes for the disadvantaged groups.
3. Assign blame for disparate outcomes by identifying the perceived power group (Hegemony).
4. Redistribute power and resources from the “power group” to the disadvantaged groups.

Definitions

Some important words to know that you may come across.

Critical theory: Is a set of beliefs or ideas that is foundational to many different disciplines in the humanities: Gender Studies, Cultural Studies, Critical Race Theory, Critical Pedagogy, Feminism, Anthropology, Literary Criticism.

Cultural Appropriation: A term used to describe the taking over of creative or artistic forms, themes, or practices by one cultural group from another. It is in general used to describe Western appropriations of non-Western or non-white forms, and carries connotations of exploitation and dominance.

Equality: Equality means everyone is given the same resources, in an effort to promote fairness, but it can only work if everyone starts from the same place and needs the same help.

Hegemony: one group or community holding all authoritative power or dominance over other groups in a given society, geographical region, and/or political system

Institutional Racism: policies, laws, practices and rules within political and social institutions (e.g. schools, businesses, the media) that advantage White Americans at the expense of People of Color.

Intersectionality: The idea that multiple identities intersect to create a whole identity. These identities that can intersect include gender, race, social class, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion, age, mental disability, physical disability, mental illness, and physical illness as well as other forms of identity. These aspects of identity are not mutually exclusive. Each element or trait of a person is inseparably linked with all of the other elements.

LGBTIQQA (or LGBTQ+): the umbrella community of people who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans*, two-spirited, queer, questioning, intersex, and/or asexual

Oppression: the unjust exercise of power by a dominant group over people who have less power such that the dominant group is privileged at the other group's expense. Oppression is the complicated and multifaceted manifestation of power and privilege.

Patriarchy: a social system and institution in which men have primary power in the political, social, economic, legal, and familial spheres; patriarchy favors male-dominated thought, and is centralized on the male narrative or perspective of how the world works and should work

Privilege: unearned opportunities, advantages, benefits, and freedoms given to dominant group members that are denied to all others; privileges are obtained at the expense of non-dominant groups, and individuals can be privileged along certain identity axes and not others.

Examples: White people can be sure that race will not work against them in moving to a new neighborhood, seeking medical attention, or being pulled over by a police officer. Christians receive time off from work or school for religious holidays while members of other religions do not.

White Supremacy: a political term to describe the system in which Whites enjoy social, economic and political benefits and preferential treatment at the expense of others.

Xenophobia: Fear and/or loathing of people who have social group identities or memberships that are different from your own; the "other" or "those people."

Roots are found in Marxist philosophy.

Roots are established in the absolute truth of God.

Seeks to divide people by differences – primarily race, gender and sexual orientation. (In actuality the race difference is ethnicity, not race.)

Seeks to unite people in love and sees one race, the human race. (Eph. 2:14-15)

Seeks to posit groups against each other by establishing degrees of perceived oppression.

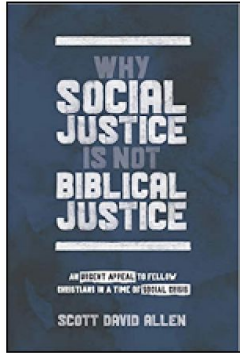
Seeks to unite people in the person of Jesus Christ and calls all believers to love people as Jesus loved us. (John 13:34; Eph. 2:14-15)

Seeks to redistribute or remove the position and wealth of the hegemony and give it to those who are identified as the oppressed

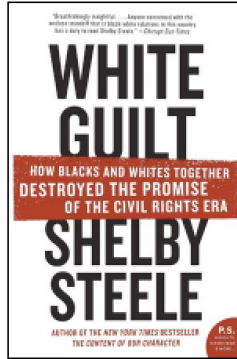
Seeks to call into conviction sin in a person's life & in mercy, grace and love lead them to repentance so as to be reconciled to God and others. This could result in restitution if needed. (Acts 10; Col 3:11)

Seeks revenge for perceived grievances. To quote Kendi : "The only remedy to past discrimination is present discrimination. The only remedy to present discrimination is future discrimination."

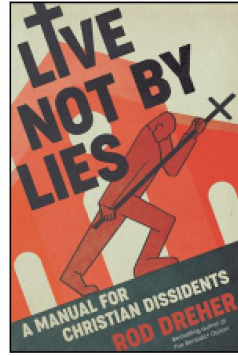
Seeks reconciliation, unity and peace.
