





Racers - Individual Times

Step 1: Log Into Your Account on the Fenworks Platform


Go to <u>app.fenworks.com</u> to log into your account on the Fenworks Platform. If you forgot your password, follow the instructions on the screen.






Step 2: Find Your Match

- 1) Your match should appear on your Dashboard under "Schedule." Click on the match and it will take you to the week where you need to upload your time.
- If you don't see a match, click on "Season" on the left side and click on the "Drone Racing Individual Season." Look at the image to make sure you choose the correct one.










Step 3: Fill in the In-Game Name Info

Fill in the in-game name from VelociDrone for the account you will use primarily for the season. You will only have to do this the first time you log in.








Step 4: Review the Season Information and Find Stages and Weeks

- 1. **Season Information:** Please review the Season Information, which will provide you with important information, such as the Track of the Week, a shortened version of the steps to submit your times, and instructions for support.
- 2. Stages: These stages show what stage you are in, such as preseason, season, or tournament.
- 3. Week: This shows you what week you are in based on the current date. Click the week button to open a drop-down menu of all weeks for that stage. To the right of the selected week, you can see the start and end date and information about that stage, such as whether the week has started or not.



Step 5: Submit Time




<u>Week Started:</u> If the week has opened, you will see this screen. You will have infinite chances to race and submit your time. **Note* Only the last time you upload will count for scoring. Please only put times that are faster than previous times**.







<u>Submitting Times:</u> To submit your time, click on the red, "Submit" button. A pop-up will appear where you will enter your time. **Please make sure to include all three (3) decimal places (Ex. 123.552).** You will be required to submit a screenshot. That screenshot must include the account name, race time, and track name in the background. See below for an example.









Step 6: Review

Click the "See Screenshots" button to see all submissions. Once you have submitted at least one time for the week, you are good, and no other action is needed. **Note* Only the last time you upload will count for scoring. Please only put times that are faster than previous times**.




Step 7: Support

If you run into any issues or have any questions, click the blue "Chat" button, and a match chat window will appear. Click the red "Flag Admin" button to flag a Fenworks Admin. A pop-up will appear. Type out your issue, and an admin will appear in the chat to assist you. Please note that it might take a few minutes for a Fenworks Admin to support you. **Note* You must click Flag Admin or else Admin will not see the message!**








Step 8: Checking Weekly and Season Leaderboards

Once the Fenworks Admin publish the times for a week, all times for all racers will be shown in rank order, as seen below. The number on the left is the rank, and the times are on the right. To see the season leaderboard, scroll to the bottom and see other racers' points and ranks.







Racers - Duos Times




Step 2: Find Your Match

- 1) Your match should appear on your Dashboard under "Schedule." Click on the match and it will take you to the week where you need to upload your time.
- 2) If you don't see a match, click on "Season" on the left side and click on the "Drone Racing Duos Season." Look at the image to make sure you choose the correct one.










Step 3: Fill in the In-Game Name Info










Step 5: Find Your Match


<u>Week Not Started:</u> Scroll down to see the current week. If the week has not started yet, you will see the "Week Has Not Started" notification. You might see some matches or no matches. If you see matches, they will indicate that they are upcoming. You cannot submit times until Fenworks Admins have opened the week. Your match will have your team's name highlighted in red and yellow.







<u>Week Started:</u> If the week has opened, you will see that all the match statuses have changed to 'In Progress.' Click on your match. Your match will have your team's name highlighted in red and yellow. If you hover over any of the teams, it will show you the full team's name, school and org name, and the GM names.




Step 6: Review the Match Page Resources and Support

Once you click on your match, you will be brought to the match page.

- 1. <u>Match Chat:</u> The top will show the match chat. This is where you can chat with the other team to get in-game names (if they are missing from the profiles), send lobby instructions, or determine if you are racing asynchronously or not. You are also able to hide the match chat.
- 2. Flag an Admin: If you run into any issues or have any questions, click the red "Flag Admin" button inside the match page to flag a Fenworks Admin. A pop-up will appear. Type out your issue, and an admin will appear in the chat to assist you. Please note that it might take a few minutes for a Fenworks Admin to support you. Note* You must click Flag Admin or else Admin will not see the message!
- 3. <u>Match Score Submission:</u> If you continue scrolling, down, you will see the score section. This is where you will enter scores for you and possibly your teammate. Click the red carrot icon to expand the game information to see all the races within a game.













Step 7: Submit Times

To submit a time, click on the oval under that racer's name. Make sure it's the correct race attempt. **You** will only be able to put in times for yourself. However, if you are the Team Captain, you can enter both you and your teammate's times. You will <u>not</u> be able to see the other teams' times until all times for a game have been submitted.

A pop-up will appear where you will enter the time. Please make sure to include all three (3) decimal places (Ex. 123.552). You will be required to submit a screenshot. That screenshot must include the account name, race time, and track name in the background. See below for an example. Note* You will only have one opportunity to submit a time per race. You cannot edit or view the screenshot submission after. Your time should appear on the screen. If you made an error, see Step 6 for support.


No further steps are needed once a team has entered all the times onto the platform. You do not have to hit the "Submit Scores" button, as it can only be clicked once all times for both teams have submitted their times. Fenworks Admin will do that at the end of the week. However, if a match does have all the times from both teams, any Team Captain or GM can submit the times.





Step 8: Checking Weekly and Season Leaderboards

Once the Fenworks Admin publish the week's results, all the match results will be shown on that week's view. To see the season leaderboard, scroll to the bottom and see other teams' win/loss records. Your team will be highlighted in blue.






Step 1: Log Into Your Account on the Fenworks Platform




Step 2: Find Your Matches

- If you don't see a match, click on "Season" on the left side and click on the "Drone Racing Individual Season." Look at the image to make sure you choose the correct one.













Step 4: Submit Times for Racers












Step 5: Review









Step 6: Support



Step 7: Checking Weekly and Season Leaderboards

As a GM, you will be able to see all screenshots for all racers, not just your racers. To see the season leaderboard, scroll to the bottom and see other racers' points and ranks.






Step 2: Find Your Matches

- 2) If you don't see a match, click on "Season" on the left side and click on the "Drone Racing Duos Season." Look at the image to make sure you choose the correct one.













Step 4: Find Your Match

If you hover over any of the teams, it will show you the full team's name, school and org name, and the GM names.









Step 5: Review the Match Page Resources and Support

Once you click on a match, you will be brought to the match page.

- 1. Match Chat: The top will show the match chat. This is where you can chat with the other team to get in-game names (if they are missing from the profiles), send lobby instructions, or determine if you are racing asynchronously or not. You are also able to hide the match chat.
- 2. Flag an Admin: If you run into any issues or have any questions, click the red "Flag Admin" button inside the match page to flag a Fenworks Admin. A pop-up will appear. Type out your issue, and an admin will appear in the chat to assist you. Please note that it might take a few minutes for a Fenworks Admin to support you. Note* You must click Flag Admin or else Admin will not see the message!
- 3. Match Score Submission: If you continue scrolling, down, you will see the score section. As a GM, you can upload all the times for your racers. Click the red carrot icon to expand the game information to see all the races within a game. Each racer can upload their own time as well. Team Captains can also upload times for both racers on their team. We encourage you to have each racer fill these out using their accounts. You will not be able to see the other teams' times until all times for a game have been submitted.





Step 6: Submit Times

To submit a time, click on the oval under that racer's name. Make sure it's the correct race attempt. You will not be able to see the other teams' times until all times for a game have been submitted. A pop-up will appear where you will enter the time. Please make sure to include all three (3) decimal places (Ex. 123.552). You will be required to submit a screenshot. That screenshot must include the account name, race time, and track name in the background. See below for an example. Note* You will only have one opportunity to submit a time per race. You cannot edit or view the screenshot submission after. Your time should appear on the screen. If you made an error, see Step 5 for support.

No further steps are needed once a team has entered all the times onto the platform. You do not have to hit the "Submit Scores" button, as it can only be clicked once all times for both teams have submitted their times. Fenworks Admin will do that at the end of the week. However, if a match does have all the times from both teams, any Team Captain or GM can submit the times.




