> The request before you is to consider a variance in Section 16.50.040 to allow an existing +/- 9.5-acre lot of record to be divided into two tracts. One tract will contain an existing home and accessory structures and will consist of +/-3.93 acres; the other will contain a commercial kennel and will consist of +/-5.57 acres. As a lot of record, the property is accessed via a non-exclusive perpetual 50FT easement. The Board approved a commercial kennel (ZON2007-00113) on August 23, 2007; a variance to the rear setback for the kennel (ZON2007-00153) on November 5, 2007. The property is located in Commission District 3.

## **Proposed Conditions if approved:**

- 1. The Board of Commissioners action letter shall be placed on the plat.
- 2. No further subdivision of the two newly created parcels shall be allowed.
- 3. No expansion of the commercial kennel or its services shall be allowed.
- 4. No dwelling shall be added to the tract containing the commercial kennel.
- 5. The following note shall be placed on the plat of record:

"Purchaser understands that to the extent that the property is accessed through the non-exclusive perpetual easement is not maintained by Hall County, does not meet Hall County's common driveway standards, and may not be accessible to emergency vehicles."

- 6. The two parcels shall be conveyed to one owner or entity.
- 7. Standard Hall County Platting procedures shall be followed.
