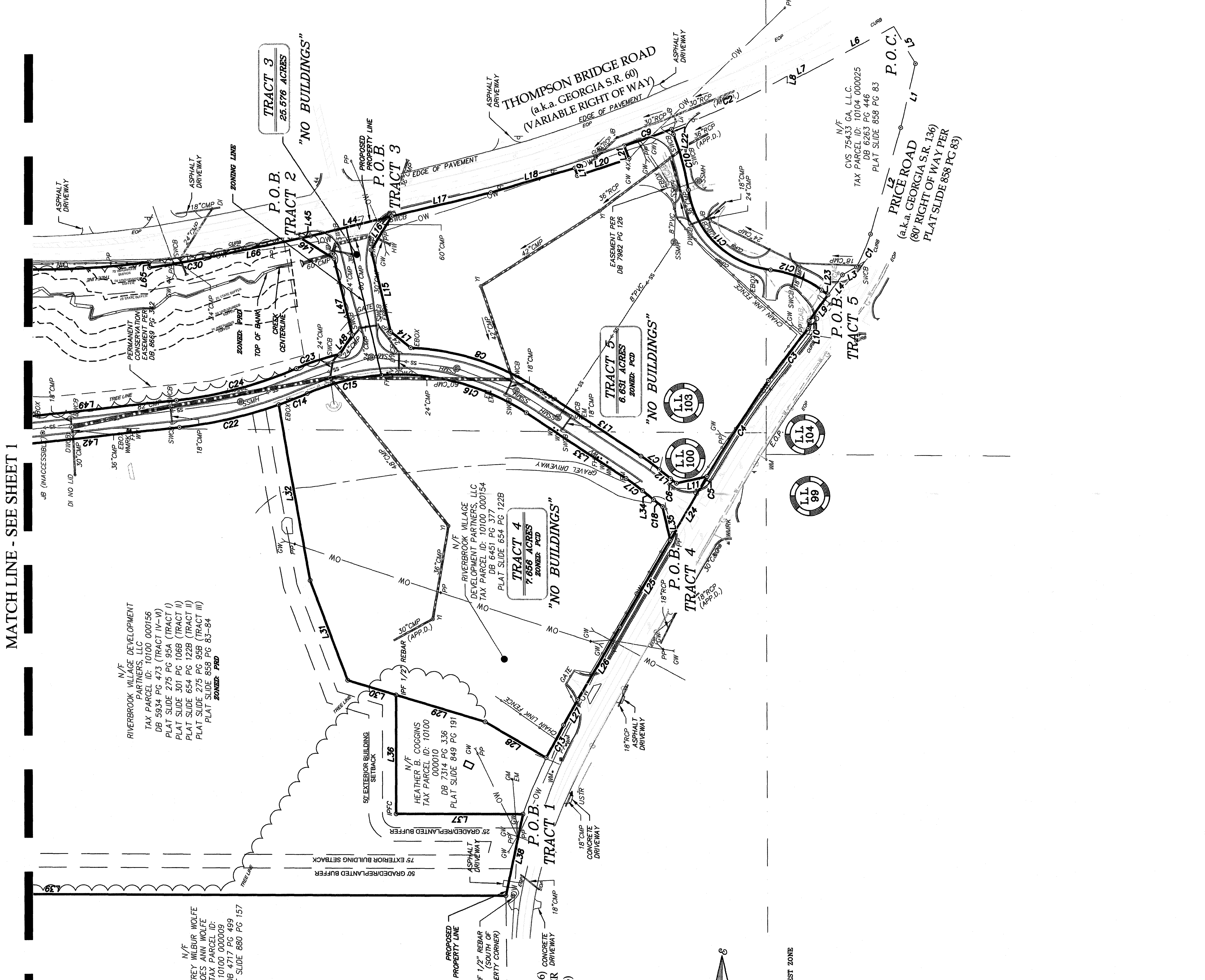

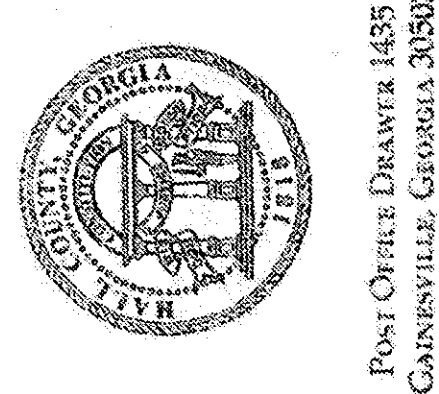

Dear Mr. Robison:

In their regular meeting of January 24, 2013, the Hall County Board of Commissioners approved your application to rezone from PCD to PKD; and to rezone from R-1, R-II, and AK-II to PKD, an 83.0± acre tract located on the west side of Thompson Bridge Road at its intersection with Price Road; a.k.a. 3740 and 3782 Price Road; Tax Parcels 10100 000154; 10100 000156; and 10100 000158. Proposed Use: Mixed use residential/commercial development with the following conditions:

1. The development of the site shall occur as generally depicted and described in the concept, landscape plans, architectural exhibits and project narrative as amended and modified as necessary for compliance with development standards in force at the time of the site plan approval.
2. All commercial development shall comply with the Gateway Corridors Overlay District (Section 17.420) standards and any standards that are applicable to this area at the time of approval.
3. The developer shall work with Hall County Traffic Engineering/GDOT on determining if any road improvements are necessary to serve the development.
4. Any access/road improvements required by Hall County or the Georgia Department of Transportation shall be the financial responsibility of the applicant or developer.
5. The development shall be limited to 220 apartment units.
6. None of the apartment units shall be income assisted.

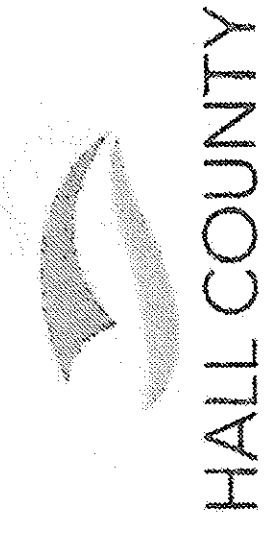
7. The amenity package for the apartments shall be built in Phase 1, when at least the first 80 units are built.
8. As depicted on the amended site plan there shall be a 100 foot building setback along the western boundary of the proposed PRD. Within the 100 foot building setback shall be a 50 foot graded and planned buffer. The proposed PCD shall have 75 foot building setback with a 30 foot graded and planned buffer.
9. Any new plats created for the development shall include all conditions of zoning approval.

Please be advised that in its Meeting on December 9, 2021, the Hall County Board of Commissioners voted to approve the following application with the listed conditions.

Application of Fuqua Acquisitions, LLC, to amend conditions of a Planned Commercial Development (PCD) on a 14.28± acre tract located on the north side of Price Road at its intersection with Walnut Grove Way, a.k.a. 3740 & 3782 Price Road, Zoned PRD; Tax Parcels 10100 000156(a) & 000154. Proposed Use: amend conditions of a planned commercial development. Commission District 2.

1. The development shall conform substantially with the proposed site plan and narrative, modified as necessary for compliance with current development standards at time of site plan approval. This includes architectural standards and sign standards as presented in the Master Sign Development Plan.
2. The proposed development standards, master sign development plan and narrative are approved. Any development standards that are not addressed in the applicants project narrative or Master Sign Development Plan shall be governed by the standards set forth by the Official Code of Hall County.
3. The total building square footage for the proposed development shall be limited to a maximum of 85,000 square feet.
4. Access to the development shall be approved by Hall County Traffic and/or the Georgia Department of Transportation, whichever applies.
5. Any necessary access modifications must be approved and permitted by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). All costs associated with any required improvements shall be the developer's responsibility.
6. Building height shall be limited to 3-stories/45 feet.

7. No outdoor storage shall be allowed for any use, with the exception of the grocery store and associated display of seasonal items along the front entrance of the store.
8. The following uses shall require a conditional use permit:
 - a. Full service car wash. Car washes associated with a gas station shall be permitted.
 - b. Self-storage facilities.
9. The following uses shall not be permitted:
 - a. Tire sales, automobile repair and maintenance businesses with the exception of auto parts and quick oil change services which shall be allowed by right.
10. The applicant shall submit architectural renderings, including building materials and colors, to be approved by the Planning Director prior to any issuance of any building permits.
11. All conditions of zoning shall be made part of any new plat created for the property.
12. The development shall adhere to the Hall County Erosion Control Ordinance Best Management Practices for Large Developments, which include the 3 BMPs from the County-approved list, even if the phase of development is less than 20 acres.
13. Hall County supports a traffic signal on Thompson Bridge Road provided the signal is permitted and approved by GDOT, and paid for by the developers.

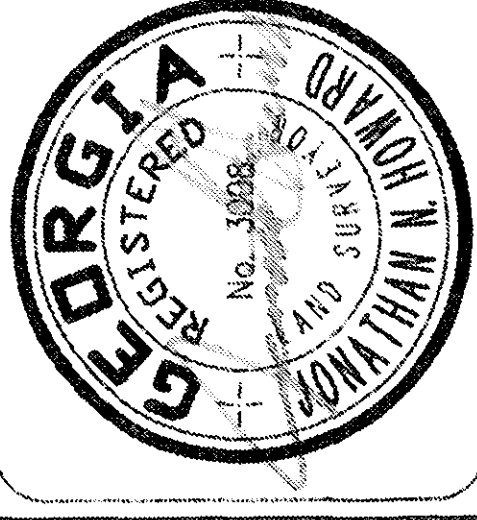
