The last major revision to the Animal Control Ordinance occurred in 2009, and the proposed revisions reflect changes based upon Hall County's experience with animal control issues.

The proposed revisions include restrictions concerning the types of facilities that may engage in the sale of animals. The revisions also address Hall County's Community Cat Program.
