DECLARATION OF TAKING

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hall County, Georgia (the "Board of Commissioners"), adopted a Resolution on May 10, 2023 (the "Authorizing Resolution"), authorizing and directing the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and the law firm of Stewart, Melvin & Frost, LLP to proceed with the condemnation of a portion of certain property located in Hall County, Georgia, for the purpose of acquiring, for public road purposes, (i) a right of way, and (ii) the permanent easements for the purpose of constructing and maintaining slopes and relocating utilities herein described, all in connection with the construction of a connecting road to be known as the Sardis Connector from East of Chestatee Road to West of S.R. 60 along S.R. 283 in Hall County, Georgia (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the original location of the Project was approved by the Georgia Department of Transportation on January 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the plans for the Project (the "Project Plans") were prepared by WSP USA, Inc. for the Georgia Department of Transportation, are entitled "Right of Way of Proposed Sardis Road Connector from East of Chestatee Road to West of S.R. 60 along S.R. 283, STP00-0003-00(626)," have a completion date of October 18, 2019, and were last revised on December 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a certified copy of said Authorizing Resolution of the Board of Commissioners and its incorporated attachments is attached hereto as <u>Schedule 1</u>, and by reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, said right of way and easements are being acquired for public road purposes upon, across, and over property owned by ANGELA CHRISTINA HIERS, A/K/A ANGELA HIERS, AS EXECUTOR OF THE ESTATE OF DOROTHY L. ALLISON, which property is described on <u>Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachment 1</u>, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof (the "Property"), which Property is located at 4023 Sardis Road, Gainesville, Hall County, Georgia, said <u>Attachment 1</u> being a description of the entirety of the Property owned by said Condemnees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found that it is necessary to acquire the title, estates, or interests in said property as provided in the Authorizing Resolution and that said taking is authorized by the provisions of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Sections 32-3-4 through 32-3-19; and

WHEREAS, the property or interests necessary to be acquired by condemnation in connection with the construction of the Project (the "Acquired Interests"), are owned by ANGELA CHRISTINA HIERS, A/K/A ANGELA HIERS, AS EXECUTOR OF THE ESTATE OF DOROTHY L. ALLISON, who may be served at 4016 Ledan Road, Gainesville, Hall County, Georgia 30506; and

WHEREAS, the Acquired Interests are described as follows:

- (A) A permanent easement for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, and maintaining slopes and relocating utilities, consisting of 0.027 acre, more or less (see <u>Exhibit</u> <u>A: Declaration of Taking, Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachment 2: Description of Permanent Easement</u>, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, for a metes and bounds description of said easement);
- (B) A temporary construction easement for the purpose of constructing slopes, consisting of 0.020 acre, more or less, (see <u>Exhibit A: Declaration of Taking, Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachment 3: Description of Temporary Easement</u>, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, for a metes and bounds description of said easement); and

WHEREAS, in order to estimate the sum of money to be deposited with the Court as just and adequate compensation for the Acquired Interests proposed to be condemned, Hall County has caused an investigation and report to be made by a competent land appraiser, a copy of the sworn statement of said appraiser being attached hereto as <u>Schedule 2: Appraiser's Statement</u> and by reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in reliance upon said Appraiser's Statement, Petitioner estimates that the just compensation to be paid for the Acquired Interests (as described in <u>Schedule 1: Resolution,</u> <u>Attachments 2 and 3</u>, attached hereto) is <u>\$900.00</u>, and contemporaneously with the filing of this Declaration of Taking, Petitioner deposits said sum in the Court for the use of the persons entitled hereto;

1. Affiant was employed by the Hall County, Georgia to appraise the property owned by Angela Christina Hiers, a/k/a Angela Hiers, as Executor of the Estate of Dorothy L. Allison located at 4023 Sardis Road, Gainesville, Georgia 30506 (Parcel No. 58), consisting of 0.027 acre permanent easement for the construction and maintenance of slopes and utility relocation and 852.51 square feet of temporary easement for the construction of slopes, required for the construction of the Sardis Road Connector Project (Federal Aid Project STP00-0003-00(626)), and makes this sworn statement to be used in connection with condemnation proceedings under the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Sections 32-3-4 through 32-3-19, for the acquisition of said parcel.
