**Subject:** **Unnamed Road | Establish a Road Name** | on the official Hall County road map from Unnamed to Old Lanier Islands Drive; being a ±0.40 mile section at the intersection of Big Creek Road and New Bethany Road, formally Lanier Islands Parkway prior to the realignment of SR 347 completed by GDOT | **Planning Staff, applicant.**

The request before you is the request of the Planning Department to establish a road name. This item is located within Commission District 2.

Due to the realignment of Lanier Islands Parkway by Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) a segment of the old alignment of Lanier Islands Parkway is being removed from GDOT maintenance and added to Hall County road maintenance. This maintenance change is due to an agreement with the Board of Commissioners and GDOT, signed and dated July 30, 2018.

The Planning Department is requesting a proposed road name establishment for this realigned segment to: **Old Lanier Islands Drive**, in order to eliminate the duplication with the new alignment. Properties located on this section will receive new addresses once the new name has been approved. Attached you will find information and location maps regarding this request.

At their April 3, 2023 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend approval **(4-0, Sosebee absent)**.

There were **two written comments in opposition** submitted in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and **no one spoke during the public hearing**.

There have been no changes to the request since the Planning Commission took action.
