Executive Summary:

Purpose of Request:

To approve the lease of Rooms 105-114 of the County's recentlyacquired Pretrial Accountability Services Building located at 1195 Jesse Jewell Parkway, Gainesville, GA to the Georgia State Properties Commission for use as the Conflict Defenders' Office, and to authorize the Chairman to execute the Master Lease Agreement and any additional documents necessary to effectuate the lease, subject to the review and approval of the County Attorney.

Facts and Issues:

The lease would be for an initial one (1) year term with five additonal option years at rates that reflect an increase in the CPI on a yearly basis. Four (4) rooms in the building would be leased exclusively by the State, and six (6) additional rooms would be common area used by both the State and County agencies. The remaining eleven rooms in the building would be used exclusively by County agencies.

History:

The County recently acquired the property located at 1195 Jesse Jewell Parkway, Gainesville, GA from the State of Georgia. The County planned to use the building as its Pretrial Accountability Services Building. The State of Georgia has also expressed interest in leasing a portion of the building to house the Conflict Defenders' Office in such a way that the lease would not interfere with County use of the building. Therefore, on December 8, 2022 the County signed a Letter of Intent with the State to lease Rooms 105 to 114 of the building to it.
