

# Zaxtai food truck and base of operation proposal

## Daily operation

- Three site inspections were done prior to purchase by Hall County officials.
- 4 permits were applied for submitted and approved after compliance.
- Site plans, general, plumbing, electrical, septic tanks floor plans submit and approved.
- The size of the base of operation (unit 5) is 800sft, the size of the food trailer is 16ft by 8ft (one parking space).
- The septic tank and grease trap is 1000gal each and was inspected and service in March 2023.
- Unit 5 was renovated with 3-compartment sink, tankless water heater, floor epoxied, storage to serve as base of operation for food trailer.
- Environmental health requires a base of operation for food trailer.
- Location for food trailer, base of operation, grease trap and drum were submit to planning and zoning to David Webb with Planning and zoning.
- Base of operation, food truck, site plan, grease disposals plan and daily operation plan submitted and approved by environmental health department.
- Base of operation building and plumbing renovations was permitted, final inspection completed and approved.
- No tables or seating for dinners.
- only online and phone order for curbside pick up are preformed and deliver to uber-eat parking spot. All orders are to-go via uber-eat and curbside pick-up.
- Only disposable utensils are used and will not be washed on site.
- Propose business hour are 11am-9pm
- ~~Truck~~<sup>Trailer</sup> will be conducting business via online order, uber eat, catering, and other event locations when not on site (Gainesville festival, Buford Fun-run, and other events in the surrounding counties.
- The ~~truck~~<sup>Trailer</sup> will return to base of operation for wastewater disposal and other operations at end of every day and be parked in parking spot per location on map.
