It is recommended that a new comprehensive traffic study be performed and submitted to determine the impact of all phases of the development. This would include ADT on Cagle Road and and Buffington Road as well as the impact to the intersection at Buffington and Cagle. Also, the study should address the new roadway projects and intersections created with the White Sulphur and Cagle Road projects which is now underway.

A sanitary sewer study should also be including illustrating how the effluent from the entire development will be pumped from each of the phases to the existing Hall County sewer system and the impact it will have on the receiving lift station.
