The request before you is the **appeal of Holly Neyman/Jane Range** of the August 7th Hall County Planning Commission decision for two variances from 17.240.010: (A) reduce the left side yard setback from 10 feet to 3 feet and (B) reduce the right side yard setback from 10 feet to 4 feet to allow a residential addition and bring the existing residence into compliance. This item is located within Commission District 2.

At their August 7, 2023 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend **approval of both variances** with two (2) conditions **(5-0)**.

There was **one (1) comment submitted** in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and **four (4) people spoke in opposition during the public hearing.**

Had the Planning Commission not been appealed, their decision would have been the final action. Approving the appeal, overturns the Planning Commission decision and denies the variance requests. Denying the appeal upholds the Planning Commission decision and approves the variance requests.

Planning Commission Approval Conditions are listed below:
