- 2. Pursuant to <u>2.60.060</u>, all applications approved by the board, whether a request for variance from the terms of <u>Title 17</u>, a request for conditional use, a request for the enlargement, change or continuance of a nonconforming use or a request to appeal a decision by an administrative official in the enforcement of <u>Title 17</u>, shall be effective for a period of six months. If no action is taken by the applicant to implement the purpose of the application by obtaining the proper permit and/or license and proceeding with the building, occupancy or establishment of business within six months from the date of approval by the board, said approval shall become null and void.
