- 4. The applicant shall coordinate and receive approval from the Georgia Department of Transportation for the site access and proposed location of the covered storage areas.
- 5. All parking and storage areas shall be paved with either asphalt or concrete.
- 6. The applicant shall be required to meet all applicable local, state, and/or federal regulations required as part of the land development process.
- 7. All conditions of zoning shall be made part of any plans created for the property.
- 8. The hours of operation for the self-storage facility shall be 6:00am-11:00pm, Monday through Sunday.
- 9. The roof material for the covered parking shall be standing seam architectural metal roof panels, with the color to be approved by the Planning and Development Director.
- 10. The 10,800 sq. ft. warehouse at the rear of the property as shown on the concept plan shall be allowed to utilize metal siding.
