**WHEREAS**, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) passed by the United States Government established the new Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program; and

**WHEREAS**, the SS4A program funds regional and local initiatives to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries through the development of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan will analyze roadway safety problems through an assessment of current conditions, engagement and collaboration with citizens, and project development; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Gainesville desires to partner with Hall County to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety throughout the City of Gainesville and Hall County; and
