- 2. A combination plat shall be recorded, including any conditions of zoning, for the three tax parcels, <u>15032F000028</u>, <u>15032F000028B</u>, and <u>15032F000060</u>.
- 3. Prior to development of the property, the applicant shall obtain a land disturbance permit for the proposed work. The scope of work shall look

at the site as a whole, not just the proposed gravel expansion, and all applicable development standards shall be applied.

- 4. The existing access drive from Monroe Drive shall be brought up to industrial access standards, subject to the review and approval of the Traffic Engineer.
- 5. The construction of a permanent bathroom structure will be required if the property is to be occupied for at least two consecutive hours. Construction of restrooms, placement of prefabricated restroom facilities, or industrialized restroom or office building, shall require a building permit and must follow standard Hall County commercial building permit processes.
- 6. The applicant shall obtain a Hall County Business License before conducting business operations at this site.
- An opaque fence of no less than 6 foot height shall be installed along the front of the property where adjacent to right-of-way. All maintenance shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
