- 5010 McKinzey Lane | Use Subject to County Commission Approval | on a 3.05± acre tract located on the east side of McKinzey Lane at its intersection with Stephens Road | Zoned V-C, Tax Parcel 08089 001019
 Proposed Use: 3-lot subdivision | ** Commission District 2 | Garry L. & Gale W. English, applicants.
 - a) Engineering: Further subdivision of these lots will results in necessity of a storm water management plan if the total number of lots reaches more than 6.
 - **b) Traffic:** Ten foot right-of-way dedication will be required along Mckinzey Lane in order to bring up to Hall County standard for ditched section. Driveways must meet Hall County driveways regulations.
 - c) Utilities: Flowery Branch sewer district but no feasible connection for sewer lines. Septic system shall comply with all Environmental Health requirements.
- 5. 7896 Calvary Cross Road | Rezone | from Planned Commercial Farm District (PCFD) to Planned Residential Development (PRD) on a 53.98± acre tract located on north side of Calvary Cross Road at its intersection with Lula Road | Zoned PCFD; Tax Parcel 12104 000005 | Proposed use: 12-lot subdivision | ** Commission District 3 | Candler Road Estate, applicant.
 - a) Engineering: The site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds

for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not center line of stream.

- b) **Traffic:** GDOT permit will be required for driveways on Lula Road (SR52). Driveways on Calvary Cross Road must meet Hall County requirements.
- c) Utilities: Hall county sewer district but no feasible sewer connection.
- 6. **0 Candler Road | Rezone |** from Agricultural Residential-IV (AR-IV) to Heavy Industrial (I-II) within the Gateway Corridors Overlay District (GCOD) on a 51.47± acre tract located on the west side of Candler Road approximately 1840 feet from its intersection with Lee Land Road | Zoned AR-IV; Tax Parcel 15031A000001 | **Proposed use: welding** service | ** Commission District 3 | **Paden M. Dunagan, applicant**.
 - a) Engineering: The site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not center line of stream. FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains present on site.
 - **b) Traffic:** Proposed driveways ties into existing Candler Road (SR60) driveways, however, GDOT will need to approve expanded use of existing driveway.
 - c) Utilities: City of Gainesville sewer district.
