## Notice - Addendum 2 <br> Project Name: Laurel Park Baseball Field Fencing IFB\#: 030-44

## December 6, 2023

The following questions were submitted by various vendors after the $1^{\text {st }}$ Addendum was issued.

Q: What about the netting over the walkways?
A: The netting over the walkways will not be part of this project. It will be bid out separately at a later date.

Q: Can you inform me on the back fence height or gate height?
A: Fields 1 and 2 - The backstops are $28^{\prime}$ high, those step down to 10 ' high fences for roughly 65 ', then to a 6 ' fence for the remainder of the foul and outfield fence.

Fields 3 and 4 - The backstops are 28 ' high, those step down to 10 ' high fences for roughly 65 ', then to a $6^{\prime}$ fence for the remainder of the foul and outfield fence.

Q: How tall are the back stops on all four (4) fields?
A: Fields 1 and 2-28'
Fields 3 and 4-20'
Q: Do you have a recommendation on the line post and gate post demotions?

A: Line posts should stand roughly 6 ' tall. Entry gate dimensions should be to be 4 ' wide and at least 7 ' tall ( 2 total per field), double gates would need to be 10 ' wide ( 2 per field), outfield gate would be 4' wide by 6 ' high.
Q: Will the dugouts be in Chain-link or Block?
A: The dugouts would be chain-link.

Q: What are the dimensions of each backstop per field (i.e., length, width \& height)?
A: Fields 1 and 2 - Backstops are $28^{\prime}$ high $-20^{\prime}$ wide along the back with another 10 ' wide section that starts down the foul line. It then steps down to a $10^{\prime}$ high section that is roughly $65^{\prime}$ long, then to a 6 ' high section that extends to the foul pole and around the outfield fence.

Fields 3 and 4 - Backstops are 20 ' high - $20^{\prime}$ wide along the back with another 10 ' wide section that starts down the foul line. It then steps down to a $10^{\prime}$ high section that is roughly 65 ' long, then to a $6^{\prime}$ high section that extends to the foul pole and around the outfield fence.

Q: What is the fence/gate heights per field?
A: The fence heights are listed above. Entry gate dimensions should be to be 4 ' wide and at least 7 ' tall ( 2 total per field), double gates would need to be 10 ' wide ( 2 per field), outfield gate would be 4 ' wide by 6 ' high.

Q: What size line posts, top rail \& terminal post per field?
A: Line Post - 2 1/2"
Top Rail - $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Terminal Post - 3 "

Q: How many gates per field and what size gate posts?
A: 5 gates total (see below for more detail). Terminal posts - 3", Top Rail - $15 / 8$ ", Line Post - 2 1/2".

Q: Will the hardware for the gates be commercial or residential?
A: Commercial.

Q: How many and what kind of gates and how wide (Double Drive, Single Panel) per field?
A: Entry gate dimensions should be to be 4 ' wide and at least 7 ' tall ( 2 total per field), double gates would need to be 10 ' wide ( 2 per field), outfield gate would be 4 ' wide by 6 ' high.
Q: For clarification, all fencing for each field will be 6ga (core) black vinyl chain link?
A: Fencing should be 6ga total with vinyl (9ga core).

Q: Will any of the fencing have Mid-rail or Bottom Rail?
A: The backstop would need a bottom rail and mid-rail supports for the lower 10' section. The adjacent.

All other Terms and Conditions remain the same.
