1.0 INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this study is to determine the traffic impact from the proposed special events facility development that will be located west of Joe Parker Road in Hall County, Georgia. The traffic analysis includes evaluation of the current operations and future conditions with the traffic generated by the development. The development will consist of a special events facility with a 7,200 square foot building and a 103-vehicle space parking lot.

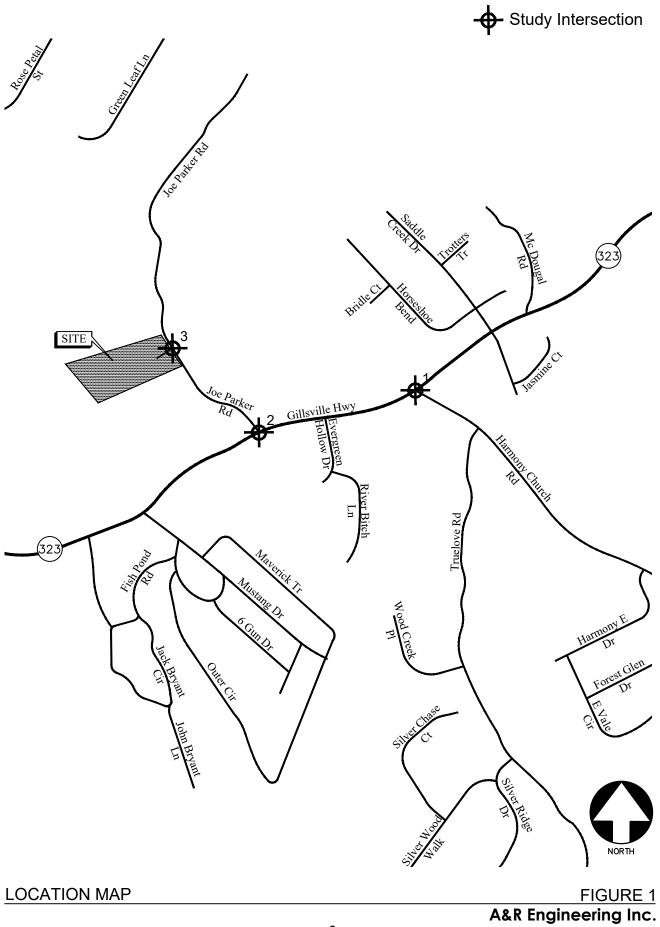


The development proposes one full access driveway on Joe Parker Road.

The AM and PM peak hours have been analyzed in this study. In addition to the site access point, this study includes the evaluation of traffic operations at the intersections of:

- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Harmony Church Road
- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Joe Parker Road

Recommendations to improve traffic operations have been identified as appropriate and are discussed in detail in the following sections of the report. The location of the development and the surrounding roadway network are shown in Figure 1.



2.0 EXISTING FACILITIES / CONDITIONS

2.1 Roadway Facilities

The following is a brief description of each of the roadway facilities located in proximity to the site:

2.1.1 SR 323 (Gillsville Highway)

SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) is an east-west, two-lane, undivided roadway with a posted speed limit of 40 mph in the vicinity of the site. Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) traffic counts (Station ID 139-0387) indicate that the daily traffic volume on SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) in 2021 was 12,300 vehicles per day West of Joe Parker Road. GDOT classifies SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) as a major collector roadway.

2.1.2 Harmony Church Road

Harmony Church Road is a north-south, two-lane, undivided roadway with a posted speed limit of 50 mph in the vicinity of the site.

2.1.3 Joe Parker Road

Joe Parker Road is a north-south, two-lane, undivided roadway with a posted speed limit of 25 mph in the vicinity of the site.

3.0 STUDY METHODOLOGY

In this study, the methodology used for evaluating traffic operations at each of the subject intersections is based on the criteria set forth in the Transportation Research Board's Highway Capacity Manual, 6th edition (HCM 6). Synchro software, which utilizes the HCM methodology, was used for the analysis. The following is a description of the methodology employed for the analysis of unsignalized and signalized intersections.

3.1 Unsignalized Intersections

For unsignalized intersections controlled by a stop sign on minor streets, the level-of-service (LOS) for motor vehicles with controlled movements is determined by the computed control delay according to the thresholds stated in Table 1 below. LOS is determined for each minor street movement (or shared movement), as well as major street left turns. LOS is not defined for the intersection as a whole or for major street approaches. The LOS of any controlled movement which experiences a volume to capacity ratio greater than 1 is designated as "F" regardless of the control delay.

Control delay for unsignalized intersections includes initial deceleration delay, queue move-up time, stopped delay, and final acceleration delay. Several factors affect the control delay for unsignalized intersections, such as the availability and distribution of gaps in the conflicting traffic stream, critical gaps, and follow-up time for a vehicle in the queue.

Level-of-service is assigned a letter designation from "A" through "F". Level-of-service "A" indicates excellent operations with little delay to motorists, while level-of-service "F" exists when there are insufficient gaps of acceptable size to allow vehicles on the side street to cross the main road without experiencing long delays.

3.2 Signalized Intersections

According to HCM procedures, LOS can be calculated for the entire intersection, each intersection approach, and each lane group. HCM uses control delay alone to characterize LOS for the entire intersection or an approach. Control delay per vehicle is composed of initial deceleration delay, queue move-up time, stopped delay, and final acceleration delay. Both control delay and volume-to-capacity ratio are used to characterize LOS for a lane group. A volume-to-capacity ratio of 1.0 or more for a lane group indicates failure from capacity perspective. Therefore, such a lane group is assigned LOS F regardless of the amount of control delay.

Table 2 below summarizes the LOS criteria from HCM for motorized vehicles at signalized intersection.

LOS A is typically assigned when the volume-to-capacity (v/c) ratio is low and either progression is exceptionally favorable, or the cycle length is very short. LOS B is typically assigned when the v/c ratio is low and either progression is highly favorable, or the cycle length is short. However, more vehicles are stopped than with LOS A. LOS C is typically assigned when progression is favorable, or the cycle length is moderate. Individual *cycle failures* (one or more queued vehicles are not able to depart because of insufficient capacity during the cycle) may begin to appear at this level. Many vehicles still pass through the intersection without stopping, but the number of vehicles stopping is significant. LOS D is typically assigned when the v/c ratio is high and either progression is ineffective, or the cycle length is long. There are many vehicle-stops and individual cycle failures are noticeable. LOS E is typically assigned when the v/c ratio is high, progression is very poor, the cycle length is long, and individual cycle failures are frequent. LOS F is typically assigned when the v/c ratio is very high, progression is very poor, the cycle length is long, and most cycles fail to clear the queue.

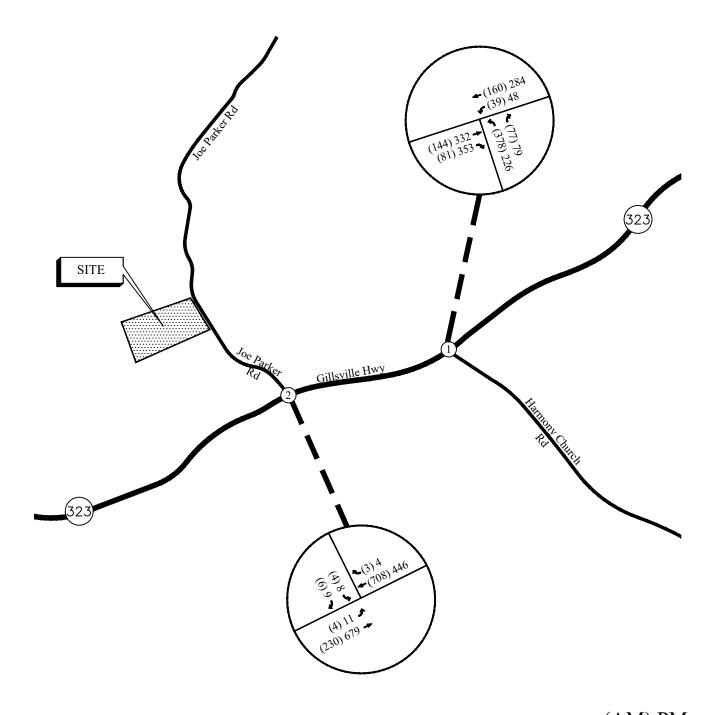
4.0 EXISTING 2023 TRAFFIC ANALYSIS

4.1 Existing Traffic Volumes

Existing traffic counts were obtained at the following study intersections:

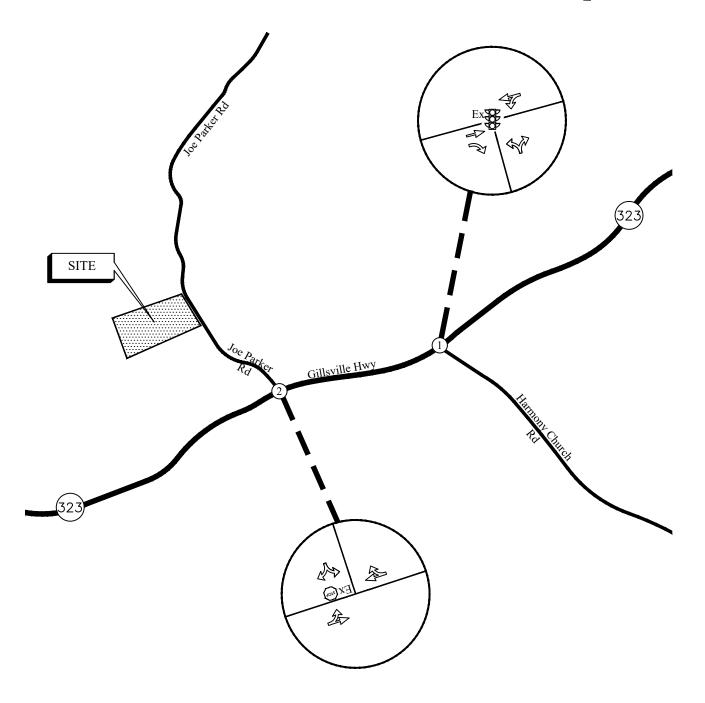
- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Harmony Church Road
- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Joe Parker Road

Turning movement counts were collected on Wednesday, March 08, 2023. All turning movement counts were recorded during the AM and PM peak hours between 7:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm, respectively. The four consecutive 15-minute interval volumes that summed to produce the highest volume at the intersections were then determined. These volumes make up the peak hour traffic volumes for the intersections counted and are shown in Figure 2.

4.2 Existing Traffic Operations

Existing 2023 traffic operations were analyzed at the study intersections in accordance with the HCM methodology. The results of the analyses are shown in Table 3.

The results of existing traffic operations analysis indicate that intersection 1 (signalized) is operating at an overall level of service "C" or better during the traffic peak hours while the approaches at intersection 2 (unsignalized) are also operating at a level of service "C" or better during both the AM and PM peak hours.

5.0 PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

The proposed special events facility development will consist of a 7,200 square foot building and a parking lot with 103 parking spaces for guests and staff.

The development proposes one full access driveway on Joe Parker Road.

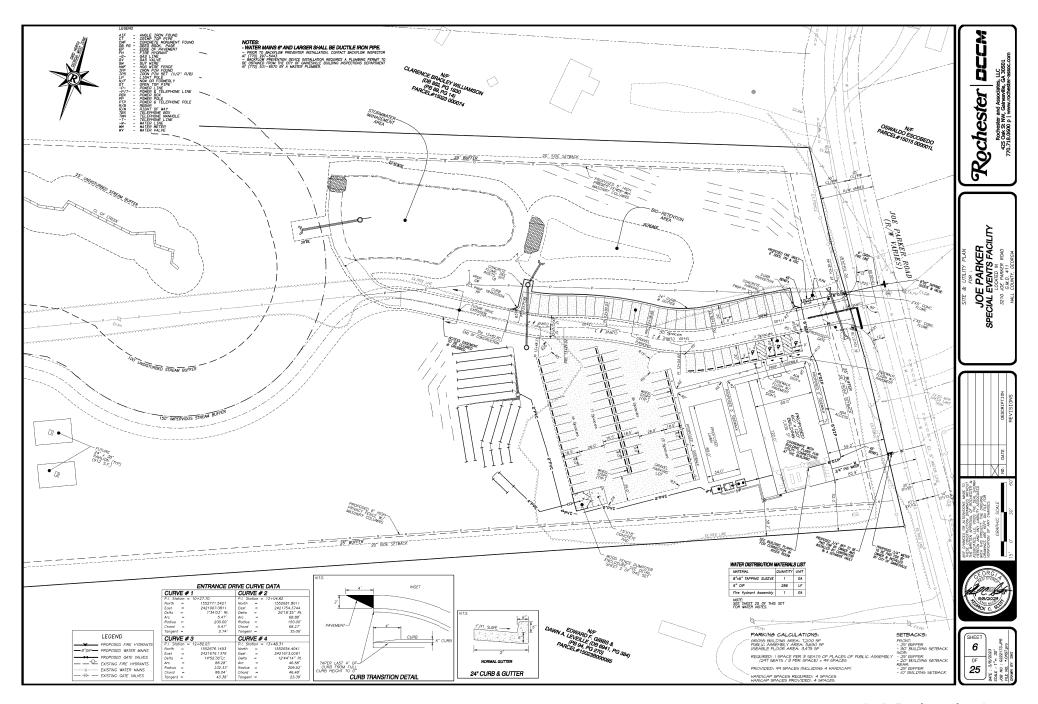
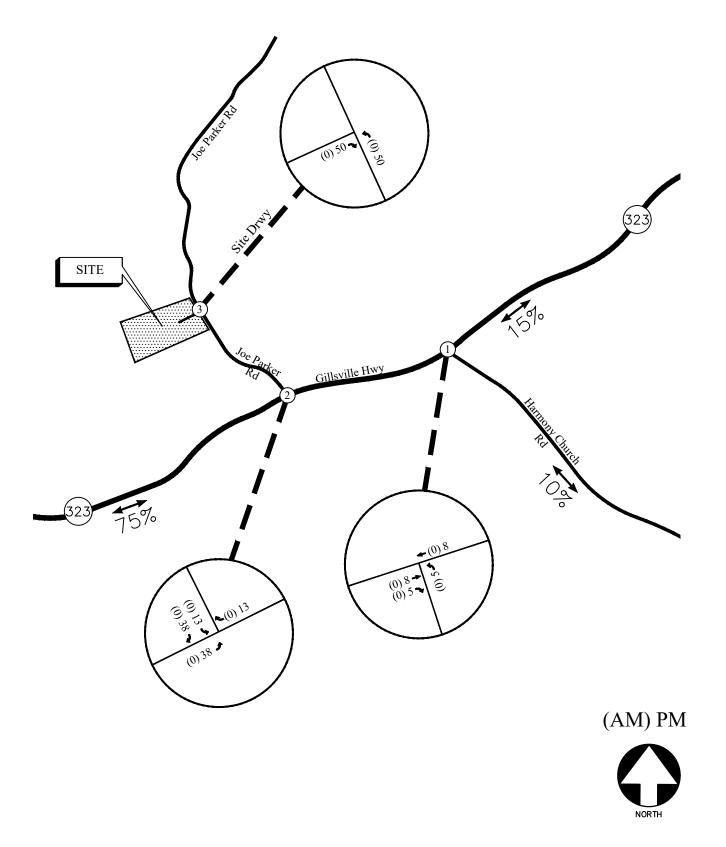


Figure 4 – Site Plan 12 A&R Engineering Inc.

A site plan is shown in Figure 4.

5.1 Trip Generation

The 11th edition of the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Trip Generation report does not include a trip generation subcategory for special events facilities, as such developments may be used for a wide variety of purposes across different times of the day and different periods of the week/month/year. Therefore, the traffic volumes for the site-generated trips to and from this development were estimated based on its planned characteristics.

The event center will primarily be used for weddings, reunions, or other social activities that require meeting or gathering space. A 7,200 square foot building will be constructed to host these events and 103 parking spaces will be available for guests and staff to use. The facility is projected to receive approximately 250 people on average per week. It is estimated that 200 people will attend each event on average, with about 65 events being planned each year. This amounts to about 1-2 events being scheduled each week, with no single day having multiple events. A realistic scenario would involve a week where one event is scheduled for the evening on a weekday and another event occurring on Saturday or Sunday. The 7,200 SF building is being designed to accommodate up to 290 guests for weddings/parties that would be considered "peak events". If each vehicle arriving carries an average of 2 guests across the course of a peak event, this amounts to 145 entering guest vehicles, plus an additional 7 cars being driven by facility/staff. Adding the 152 exiting vehicles at the end of the event amounts to an estimated total of 304 (entering/exiting) trips for a peak event that was reserved for a single day. However, guests will be arriving and leaving at different times throughout each event, so not all traffic will arrive or leave within a single peak hour.

To estimate peak hour traffic, a scenario with 50 entering cars (roughly 1/3 of all the entering traffic volume for the entire event) and 50 exiting cars is taken for the PM peak hour. No site-generated traffic was assigned to the AM peak hour, as the facility will generally not be used in the morning. Additionally, no analysis was conducted for Saturday peak hour traffic as weekend volumes are significantly lower due to the lack of school traffic and drivers commuting to work. Even after the addition of site-generated traffic in the future, the study area will still experience relatively low volumes compared to weekend PM peak hour traffic. The estimated total trip generation for the proposed development is shown in Table 4.

5.2 Trip Distribution

The trip distribution describes how traffic arrives and departs from the site. An overall trip distribution was developed for the site based on a review of the existing travel patterns in the area and the locations of major roadways and highways that will serve the development. The site-generated peak hour traffic volumes, shown in Table 4, were assigned to the study area intersections based on this distribution. The outer-leg distribution and AM and PM peak hour new traffic generated by the site are shown in Figure 5.

6.0 FUTURE 2025 TRAFFIC ANALYSIS

The future 2025 traffic operations are analyzed for the "Build" and "No-Build" conditions.

6.1 Future "No-Build" Conditions

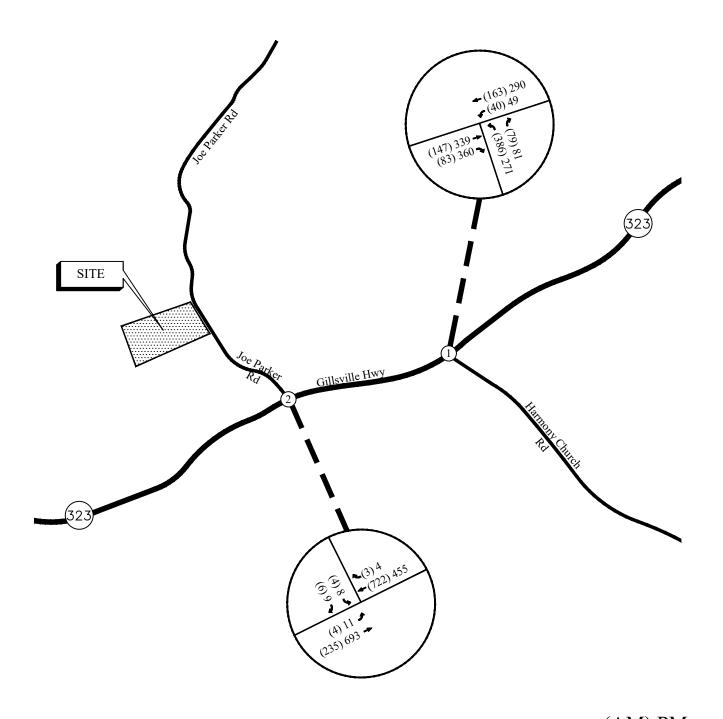
The "No-Build" (or background) conditions provide an assessment of how traffic will operate in the study horizon year without the study site being developed as proposed, with projected increases in through traffic volumes due to normal annual growth. The Future "No-Build" volumes consist of the existing traffic volumes (Figure 2) plus increases for annual growth of through traffic.

6.1.1 Annual Traffic Growth

To evaluate future traffic operations in this area, a projection of normal traffic growth was applied to the existing volumes. The Georgia Department of Transportation recorded average daily traffic volumes at several locations in the vicinity of the site. Reviewing the growth over the last three years revealed growth of approximately 1% in the area. This growth factor was applied to the existing traffic volumes between collector and arterial roadways to estimate the future year traffic volumes prior to the addition of site-generated traffic. The resulting Future "No-Build" volumes on the roadway are shown in Figure 6.

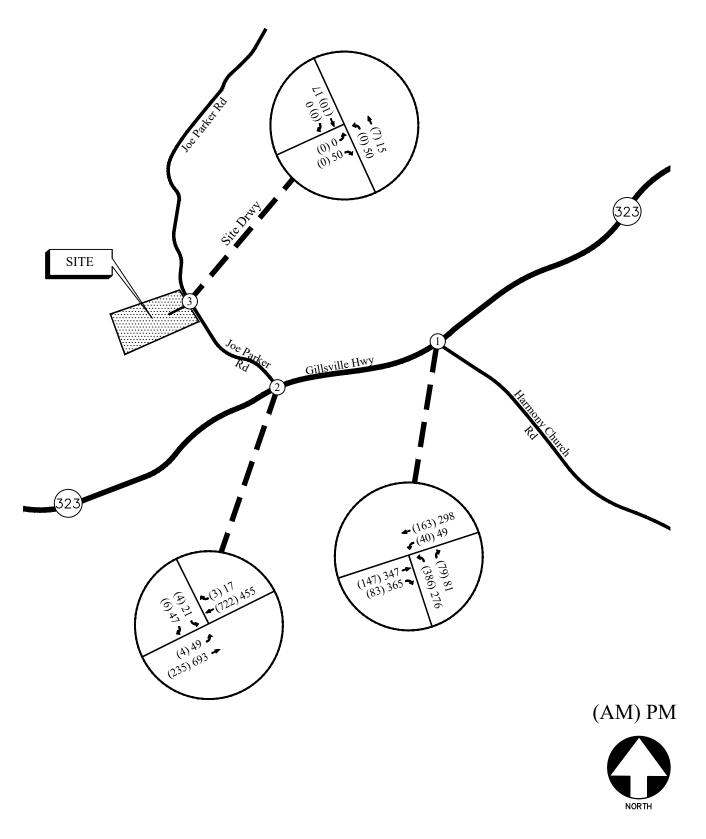
6.2 Future "Build" Conditions

The "Build" or development conditions include the estimated background traffic from the "No-Build" conditions plus the added traffic from the proposed development. To evaluate future traffic operations in this area, the additional traffic volumes from the site (Figure 5) were added to base traffic volumes (Figure 6) to calculate the future traffic volumes after the construction of the development. These total future "Build" traffic volumes are shown in Figure 7.



(AM) PM





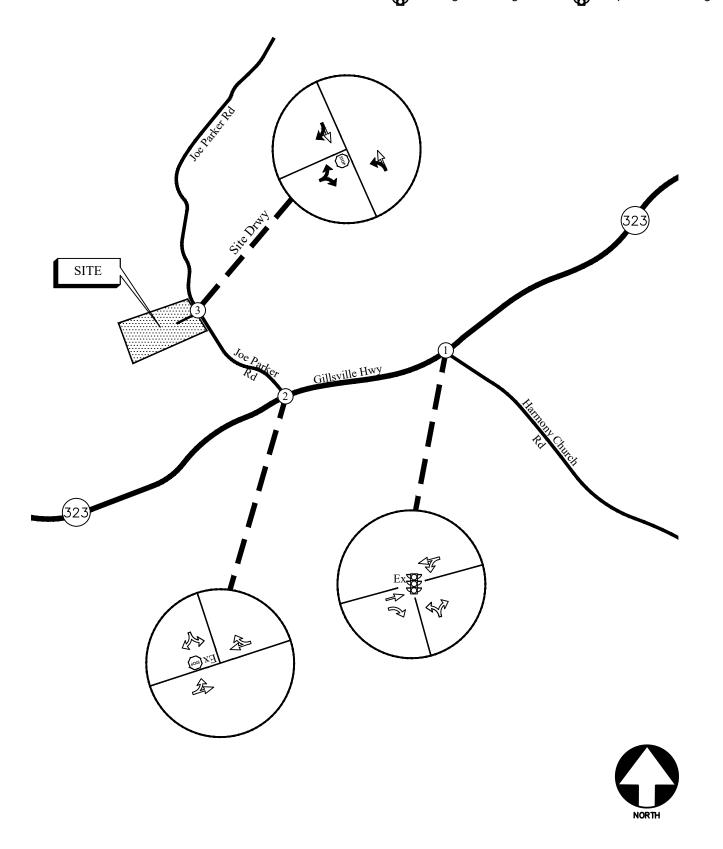
FUTURE (BUILD) WEEKDAY PEAK HOUR VOLUMES

6.3 Future "Build" Traffic Operations

The future "No-Build" and "Build" traffic operations were analysed using the volumes in Figure 6 and Figure 7, respectively. The results of the future traffic operations analysis are shown below in Table 5. Recommendations on traffic control and lane geometry are shown in Figure 8.

The results of future traffic operations analysis indicate that the signalized intersection 1 (SR 323 at Harmony Church Road) will continue to operate at a level of service "C" or better during the traffic peak hours, while the approaches at the unsignalized intersections will operate at level of service "C" or better in both the AM and PM peak hours.



FUTURE TRAFFIC CONTROL AND LANE GEOMETRY

7.0 CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Traffic impacts were evaluated for the proposed special events facility development that will be located west of Joe Parker Road in Hall County, Georgia. The development will consist of a special events facility with a 7,200 square foot building and a 103-vehicle space parking lot.

The development proposes one full access driveway on Joe Parker Road.

Existing and future operations after completion of the project were analyzed at the intersections of:

- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Harmony Church Road
- SR 323 (Gillsville Highway) at Joe Parker Road
- Joe Parker Road at Proposed Site Driveway

The analysis included the evaluation of Future operations for "No-Build" and "Build" conditions, both of which account for increases in annual growth of through traffic. The results of future traffic operations analysis indicate that the signalized intersection 1 (SR 323 at Harmony Church Road) will continue to operate at a level of service "C" or better during the traffic peak hours, while the approaches at the unsignalized intersections will operate at level of service "C" or better in both the AM and PM peak hours. Based on the analysis, the proposed development will have minimal impact on traffic operations in the study network.

7.1 Recommendations for Site Access Configuration

The following access configuration is recommended for the proposed site driveway intersection.

- Site Driveway: Full access driveway on Joe Parker Road
 - One entering lane and one exiting lane
 - Stop-sign controlled on the driveway approach with Joe Parker Road remaining free flow
 - o Provide adequate sight distance per AASHTO standards
