 - **b.** Traffic: No parking on right-of-way permitted. A portion of the parking lot for building 3 is shown on the right-of-way and will need to be relocated. As shown, driveways for building 1 do not appear to meet driveway regulations (code 12.40).

Engineering:** This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage. Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream.
 - Show FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains that are present on site.
 - **b. Traffic:** Recommend a condition that requires the recommendations outlined in the traffic impact study be implemented and all costs associated with the improvements be the financial responsibility of the applicant/developer.
 - c. Utilities: Gainesville/ Hall sewer district: no sewer connection within feasible distance.
