- 3. <u>3580 and 3526 Poplar Springs Road and 3601 Pierce Drive | Amend</u> Conditions of a PRD | on a combined 97.48± acre tract located on the south side of the Poplar Springs Road at its intersection with Poplar Springs Church Road | Zoned PRD; Tax Parcel 15036A000001, 000003 & 000011 | Proposed Use: 192-lot single-family development | ** Commission District 1 | Clint Dixon for Clayton Properties Group, Inc, applicant.
 - a. **Engineering:** Show FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains that are present on site

This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage

Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream.

- 4. <u>4363 Sardis Road | Rezone | from Agricultural Residential III (AR-III) to Planned</u> Residential Development (PRD) on a on a 41.71± acre parcel located on the west side of Sardis Road, approximately 361 feet from its intersection with Short Road | Zoned AR-III; Tax Parcel 10075 000004 | **Proposed use: 125-lot single** family development | ** Commission District 2 | Grace of Georgia Developments, LLC, applicant.
 - a. **Engineering:** This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream
 - b. Traffic: Per Hall County code 16.60.290, a left turn lane (in addition to a decel lane) is required.
 Roadways depicted in the site do not meet Hall County subdivision regulations (Hall County Code Title 16). Any variances to these regulations will need to specific, justified and considered/approved during the rezoning process.
 Dual cul-de-sacs depicted on one roadway is not permitted.

No parking spaces along roadways permitted. Mail kiosk site will need to be modified per our typical.

- 6. 2554 White Sulphur Road | Rezone | from Agricultural Residential III (AR-III) to Planned Residential Development (PRD) | on a 11.94± acre tract on the east side of White Sulphur Road, approximately 230 feet from its intersection with Ramsey Circle | Zoned AR-III; Tax Parcel 15020C000005 | Proposed Use: 53-unit townhome development | ** Commission District 3 | CMWB Company, LLC, applicant.
 - a. **Engineering:** This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream.

b. Traffic: Access along White Sulphur Road must be reviewed/approved/permitted through the City of Gainesville. Internal roadways depicted in the site plan do not meet Hall County regulations (hall County Code Title 16). Any variance will need to be specific, justified and considered/approved during the rezoning process. This would include, but not be limited to, curve radius, no dead end roads, etc.

On street parking spaces are not permitted by Hall County code. Mail kiosk design does not meet county requirements.
