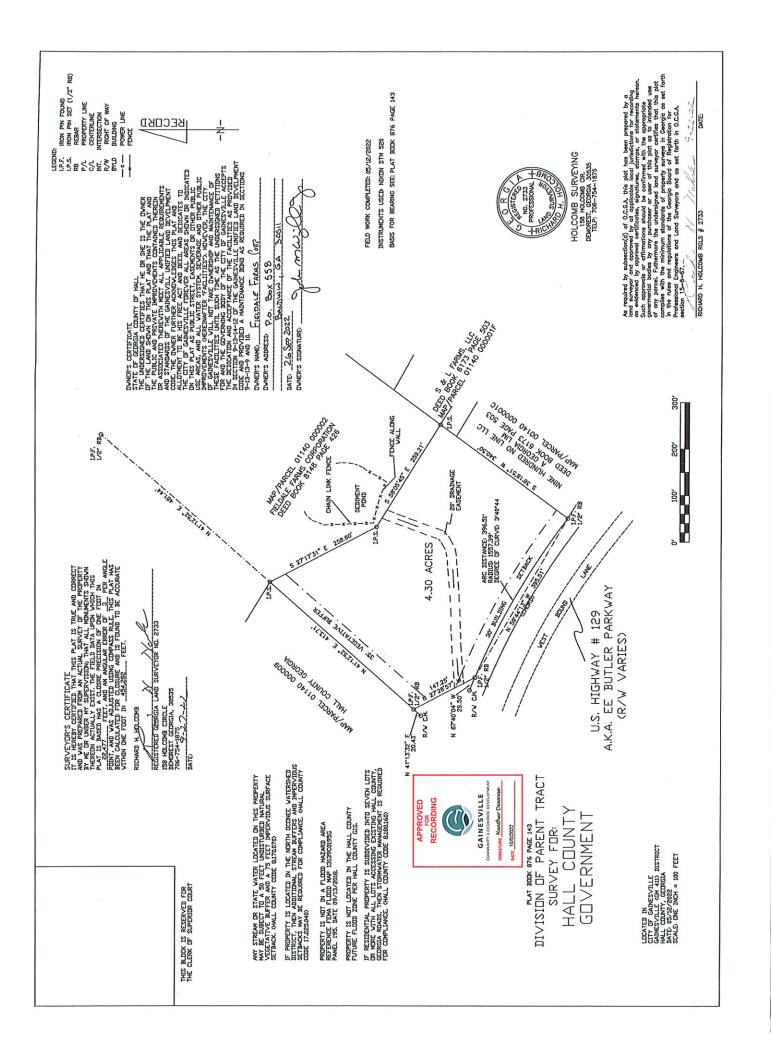


Exhibit "A" Property Description

THENCE along the line common with now or formerly Hall County, North 41°12'52" East a distance of 413.71' to a 1/2" rebar set; THENCE along the line common with now or formerly Fieldale Farms Corporation South 27°17'31" East a distance of 258.60' to a 1/2" rebar set; THENCE South 58°05'45" East a distance of 259.21' to a 1/2" rebar set; THENCE along the line common with now or formerly Nine Hundred No Line, LLC South 36°18'51" West a distance of 340.50' to a 1/2" rebar found at the northerly right of way of U.S. Highway #129 a.k.a. E.E. Butler Parkway; THENCE along said right of way and following a curve to the left with an arc length of 396.51', a radius of 1557.39', and being subtended by a chord bearing of North 59°44'13" West for a distance of 395.51' to a 1/2" rebar found; THENCE North 27°28'57" West a distance of 147.25' to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**;
