Approve Change Order #2 for the addition of professional service hours to complete the implementation of the Phase 2 upgrade of Accela Civic Applications software for Planning & Development to		History: This request is to add 203 hours to the Accela Civic Application implementation and upgrade project, originally approved in 2020, to migrate off of legacy Accela Tidemark software that was originally implemented in 1999. The Tidemark system is an Accela legacy product with a client/server architecture and is no longer under support.			
Accela, Inc. of San Ramon, CA, in the		This software implementation is shared across multiple jurisdictions that were historically using the Accela Tidemark software. Hall County and Gainesville (25% stakeholder), have been Tidemark partners since 1999. In 2006 Oakwood (4% stakeholder) joined the group using the system for their building permit and planning functions.			
Facts and Issues:		Options:			

This agreement is necessary in order to finish the implementation and build out of the software utilized by the teams within Community Development and Infrastructure. This project is shared across multiple jurisdictions in order to migrate off of an outdated Accela Tidemark product that is no longer supported. Gainesville and Oakwood are included in this software implementation and are contributing to the cost, Gainesville 25% (\$9,642.50) and Oakwood 4% (\$1,542.80), as is specified in their intergovernmental agreements.

Change order #1 was previously issued to add an additional 525 hours for a cost of \$99,750. After further review, it was determined that an additional 203 hours were needed to complete the project. Approving this change order will bring the total value of this contract to \$138,320.00.

The implementation project is wrapping up and additional funding is needed to add hours to the project for professional services via the Accela team. Further tailoring of the product is necessary and requested of the jurisdictions. Vital to the success of this project is the data conversion of the permitting, zoning, and public works records that these hours will go towards migrating from the Tidemark software to the Civic Application software.
