DECLARATION OF TAKING

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Hall County, Georgia (the "Board of Commissioners"), adopted a Resolution on March 14, 2024 (the "Authorizing Resolution"), authorizing and directing the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and the law firm of Stewart, Melvin & Frost, LLP to proceed with the condemnation of a portion of certain property located in Hall County, Georgia, for the purpose of acquiring, for public road purposes, certain rights of way and temporary easements for the purpose of constructing slopes in connection with roadway improvements for and the realignment of White Sulphur Road in Hall County, Georgia (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Project is located in Land District 19, G.M.D. 403 and 411, and Land Lot 111 of Hall County, Georgia, and consists of the realignment of White Sulphur Road to improve traffic flow in the vicinity as a result of the Blue Ridge Connector (Inland Port); and

WHEREAS, plans for the Project were designed by Volkert, Inc. and are entitled "White Sulphur Road Realignment Project," Purchase Order Number 1162100, and have an approval date of February 14, 2023 (the "Project Plans"); and

WHEREAS, a certified copy of said Authorizing Resolution of the Board of Commissioners and its incorporated attachments is attached hereto as Schedule 1, and by reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, said rights of way and easements are being acquired for public road purposes upon, across, and over property owned by BENJI BRONSON MILLER, which property is described on Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachment 1, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof (the "Property"), which Property is located at 3340 Seymour Road, Gainesville, Georgia 30501 ("Parcel 4"); 3331 Seymour Road, Gainesville, Georgia 30501 ("Parcel 5"); 3337 Seymour Road, Gainesville, Georgia 30501 ("Parcel 6"), said Attachment 1 being a description of the entirety of the Property owned by said Condemnee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found that it is necessary to acquire the title, estates, or interests in said property as provided in the Authorizing Resolution and that said taking is authorized by the provisions of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Sections 32-3-4 through 32-3-19; and

WHEREAS, the property or interests necessary to be acquired by condemnation in connection with the construction of the Project (the "Acquired Interests"), are believed to be owned by BENJI BRONSON MILLER, whose address is 3337 Seymour Road, Gainesville, Georgia 30501; and

WHEREAS, the Acquired Interests are described as follows:

- c. A temporary easement for the purpose of constructing and maintaining slopes, consisting of 0.003 acre, more or less. A metes and bounds description of said temporary easement is attached hereto as <u>Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachment 11</u>, and by reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in order to estimate the sum of money to be deposited with the Court as just and adequate compensation for the Acquired Interests proposed to be condemned, Hall County has caused an investigation and report to be made by a competent land appraiser, a copy of the sworn statement of said appraiser being attached hereto as <u>Schedule 2: Appraiser's Statement</u>, and by reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, in reliance upon said Appraiser's Statement, Petitioner estimates that the just compensation to be paid for the Acquired Interests (as described in <u>Schedule 1: Resolution,</u> <u>Attachments 2-12</u> (Schedule 1: Attachment 12 being a plat showing the lands taken) attached hereto) is **\$421,900.00** and contemporaneously with the filing of this Declaration of Taking, Petitioner deposits said sum in the Court for the use of the persons entitled hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the premises considered, Hall County, Georgia, under authority of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Sections 32-3-4 through 32-3-19, hereby declares that the Acquired Interests (as described in <u>Schedule 1: Resolution, Attachments 2-12</u>, attached hereto and made a part of this Declaration), are being taken for county road purposes.
