Subject: **6545 Misty Harbor Court | Use Subject to County Commission Approval** | 17.60.040.H Minor subdivisions | on a 7.41± acre tract | **Proposed Use: 5-lot subdivision | Yunsoon Kim, applicant.**

The request before you is the request of Yunsoon Kim for a Use Subject to County Commission Approval to allow a 5-lot subdivision. This item is located within Commission District 2.

At their February 5, 2024 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend approval with eight (8) conditions **(5-0)**.

There were **no comments submitted** in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and **no one spoke during the public hearing.**

There have been no changes to the request since the Planning Commission took action.

Planning Commission Conditions:

1. The property shall be developed in accordance with the site plan dated August 28, 2023 and as described in the project narrative dated October 30, 2023, modified as necessary for compliance with conditions herein and development standards enforced at the time of site plan approval.
2. The property shall be subdivided into a maximum of 5 building lots in accordance with the requirements of the Residential-I (R-I, [17.60](#)) zoning district as detailed in [17.240](#), area and setback requirements.
3. Development shall be limited to site-built homes having no less than 2,500 square feet of heated floor space.
4. All residences shall have sodded front yards with a professional landscape design.
5. All facades shall be finished with a combination of brick, stone, stucco, or fiber cement siding. The front façade shall incorporate changes in these building materials with different textures and/or colors. Vinyl

siding is prohibited. Homes shall be consistent with the submitted renderings. Final review and approval of building elevations is subject to the Director of Community Development and Infrastructure, or their designee.

6. All lots shall have access off of an internal roadway, with no lot having direct access to Gaines Ferry Road.
7. All conditions of zoning shall appear on any plats created for the subdivision.
8. Per [2.60.060](#). – effective period of approved applications, all applications approved by the board, whether a request for variance from the terms of Title 17, a request for conditional use, a request for the enlargement, change or continuance of a nonconforming use or a request to appeal a decision by an administrative official in the enforcement of Title 17, shall be effective for a period of six months. If no action is taken by the applicant to implement the purpose of the application by obtaining the proper permit and/or license and proceeding with the building, occupancy or establishment of business within six months from the date of approval by the board, said approval shall become null and void.
