The neighboring property at 6571 Johnson Circle got a retroactive building permit for a storage building that was encroaching on the property line of 6585 Johnson Circle. The approval from planning was to relocate the structure to meet setbacks (site plan attached). It appears the structure showed up between 2018 and 2020. I have also attached an image showing that it was later removed between 2021 and 2023. No variance was applied for.

One variance was applied for in 2006 located at 6620 Johnson Circle. However, this variance was denied. The property does appear to have structures located close to the front and side property lines that appeared between 2005 and 2010. I do not see any permits for these structures and no primary residence exists on the lot.
