Hall County Sheriff's Office is in need of providing their 230,000 citizens with Mental Healthcare in its correctional institutions. Currently Hall County is in the search for a Georgia-based, physician-owned company that provides healthcare in jails and prisons. Hall County believes that all people, regardless of their legal status, deserve high-quality and humane medical care. In addition, Hall County recognizes the unique medical and public-health issues that currently exist and continue to rise. Hall County would like to utilize this as an opportunity to intervene in an individual's life and attempt to provide much-needed care for this often-underserved population. Hall County has partnered with healthcare providers who seek to assist with this growing concern. Hall County has supported an existing Lieutenant who is currently finalizing a doctorate degree in the mental health field into a mental health role within the correctional institutions. Having this education and insight will assist Hall County to oversee this program to have the highest degree of impact on their citizens.
