Which are estimated to be complete in Summer 2025 and Spring 2025 respectively. | | |
| | | Cagle Road Improvements construction was awarded in April 2024 and White Sulphur realignment is expected to be awarded in August 2024. | | |

The proposed task orders are for design related services necessary to obtain permits, generate construction plans, and bid out to contractors for these projects. Task orders were submitted to our 3 on-demand consultants and we received responses from two of the three.

For Task order 2024-027 WSR widening and intersection improvements @ SR365. Atlas provided the most efficient time to completion – Which was 18 months (14 months by Atlas and 4 months of GDOT involvement) compared to 30 months proposed by HGB. The schedule advantage is compelling justification based on the upcoming construction activities in this area.

For Task order 2024-029 Cagle Road @ SR365. Atlas was the lowest fee and also provided the most efficient time to completion — Which was 10 months (6 months by Atlas and 4 months of GDOT involvement) compared to 30 months proposed by HGB.
