1. 2615 Pemmican Run | Variance | 17.240.010. to reduce the front yard setback | on a 1.33± acre tract located on the south side of Pemmican Run, approximately 2,400 feet from its intersection with Bruce Drive | Zoned V-C; Tax Parcel 08004 000001A | Proposed Use: Single-family residence | * Commission District 2 | Bridget Conner, applicant

a. Engineering: Show FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains that are present on site

b. Traffic: No comment.

c. Utilities: City of Gainesville Sewer district

- 3302 & 3212 Antioch Campground Road and 3446, 3450 & 3456
 Looper Lake Road | Rezone | from Agricultural Residential III (AR-III) to Planned Residential Development (PRD) | on a combined 59.31± acre tract located on the south side of Antioch Campground Road at its intersection with Looper Lake Road | Zoned AR-III; Tax Parcels 10096 000006, 000004, 000059, 000061, and 000062 | Proposed Use: 115-lot single-family development | ** Commission District 2 | The Revive Land Group, LLC, applicant
 - a. Engineering: This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage. Show FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains that are present on site Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream.
 - **b. Traffic:** Roadways must meet Hall County subdivision regulations (code Chapter 16).

Decel (right turn) lanes are required for both proposed access points per code 16.60.290.

Mail kiosk must meet post master and Hall County standards.

 - **a.** Engineering: Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream.
 - All Stream crossing pipe system to be reviewed by engineering.
 - **b.** Traffic: No comment
 - **c. Utilities:** Hall County sewer district No connection within feasible distance.
