The US Department of Transportation's Rural Surface Transportation Grant Program's objectives are to invest in surface transportation infrastructure projects of national or regional significance, or improve/expand infrastructure in rural areas; and to support projects that are consistent with the Department's strategic goals of improving safety, economic strength and global competitiveness, equity, and climate and sustainability.

This project will fund a portion of costs to widen a crash prone two-lane rural road in rapidly growing south Hall County, Georgia. This project will link communities in Flowery Branch with Braselton, while also connecting isolated parts of a multi-county multi-use path system via Spout Springs Road Widening Project, Phase II. GDOT PI 0015280, Phase II, will conclude a process that started in 2004 as a priority project.
