Purpose of Request:

Approve the ratification of the application for the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council's FY2023 Accountability Court Housing Grant for Treatment Services to provide transitional and emergency housing assistance for participants in the amount of \$99,320.00, and if awarded, appoint the Grants Manager as the Program Designee, and authorize the Chairman to execute all related award documents. The 25% match requirement will be satisfied using the Case Manager's salary paid by the state-funded Council of Accountability Court Judges grant.

History:

This will be the first year Hall County Treatment Services receives the CJCC Housing Grant.

Facts and Issues:

Options:

The accountability courts of the Northeastern Judicial Circuit (Hall and Dawson County) will collaborate with local extended stay hotels and sober living providers to provide rental assistance to program participants. Each week, Hall County's Treatment programs deny admittance to eligible participants simply due to the lack of stable housing in our counties. This barrier to treatment has lasting negative effects, on not only the participant, but also their family and our communities as a whole. Funding through this Housing Assistance Grant will allow us to reach a much larger network of qualified candidates, which, in turn, will reduce recidivism rates and provide a direct cost-savings to our local communities. Funding is available to provide emergency shelter at a local motels for up to 3 days and provide 2 months of rental assistance for participants in local sober living facilities. Treatment Services intends to request funding in both available areas to directly benefit our program participants and increase overall census.

Emergency Shelter for 26 participants: \$385/week x 4 weeks = \$1,540 = \$40,040 Recovery-Transitional Housing for 19 participants: \$1,000 entry fee + (\$1,060/month x 2 months) = \$59,280 Total = \$99,320 (521000 - professional services) The salary expense provides the 25% match needed for the grant.
