The request before you is the request of Lewis Holdings, LLC to amend Conditions of a Planned Residential Development (PRD) to allow a drug and alcohol residential treatment facility. This item is located within Commission District 3.

At their February 5, 2024 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend approval with six (6) conditions (5-0).

Staff recommendation: **Approval, with conditions** as the requested changes are consistent with the Rural future land use classification in the Comprehensive Plan.

There were no comments submitted in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and two (2) people spoke in favor during the public hearing.

Planning Commission Conditions:

- The property shall be developed in accordance with the site plan dated December 6, 2023 and as described in the project narrative submitted on December 11, 2023, modified as necessary for compliance with conditions herein and development standards enforced at the time of site plan approval.
- 2. Metal buildings and chain link fencing are prohibited.
- 3. Any outdoor lighting on the premises shall be of a non-spill type.
- 4. All conditions of zoning shall be made part of any plat(s) or plans created for the property.
- 5. The developer shall cooperate with the Fire Marshal's office, and all other appropriate departments and agencies, to obtain proper and retroactive permits for any improvements that were not previously approved.
