- **b. Traffic:** Existing Old Fork Rd and Brand Drive Right of way is 30' Dedicate additional right of way to be 30' from the centerline and widen existing pavement at least 20'
- c. Utilities: Septic tank lots Gainesville sewer area

Gilliam, applicant a. **Engineering:** This site may require a stormwater management report should the site plan indicate the proposed development meets stormwater thresholds for impervious surfaces and/or disturbed acreage.

Show stream buffer and impervious setback from wrested vegetation not centerline of stream Show FEMA and Hall County studied Flood plains that are present on site.

- **b.** Traffic: A left turn lane and decel lane will be required for the entrance. Any required roadway improvements will be the financial responsibility of the developer A cul-de-sac should be provided for Guth Road at the proposed end of county maintenance
- **c.** Utilities: No sanitary sewer in area. 76,800 gallons per day residential this is in the Hall County service area.
