The request before you is the request of Steven P. Gilliam to rezone from Agricultural Residential-III (AR-III) to Planned Residential Development (PRD) for a 256-lot residential development. This item is located within Commission District 1.

At their September 16, 2024 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend denial (4-1) Braswell opposed.

Staff recommendation: **Denial** as the proposed use exceeds the maximum density of 2 dwelling units per acre for the Residential future land use classification in the Comprehensive Plan.

There were twenty-two (22) comments submitted in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and seven (7) people spoke in opposition during the public hearing.
