I strongly oppose the residential development proposed at 3454 Gillsville Highway, because of severe traffic hazards at that location.

DANGEROUS INTERSECTION:

I live and work nearby, and the intersection of Gillsville Highway with East Hall Road is the most dangerous part of my drive every day. The intersection is awkward and has poor visibility. School buses cannot even make their right turns onto Gillsville Highway without going across the center line. And there are a lot of school buses using this intersection. Traffic turning from Gillsville Hwy onto East Hall Road often has to sit and wait to turn. Vehicles coming east on Gillsville Hwy, behind them, down the steep hill, often have to stop... but sometimes can't.

Traffic has increased the last few years, and is expected to continue to increase. One neighbor who lives and works close to the intersection counts several accidents happening most months.

INADEQUATE VISIBILITY, DUE TO BLIND CURVE & STEEP HILL ON EAST SIDE OF PROPOSED SUBDIVISION:

Eastbound vehicles would come around the blind curve, and start down the steep hill, whose curvature hides the development entrance until you're practically on top of it. Drivers may not see vehicles pulling out of the development until too late to avoid a collision. Likewise, vehicles pulling out of the development would not be able to easily see oncoming eastbound traffic in time.

To add another difficult and dangerous ingredient to this area would be deadly.

For safety's sake, do not allow this.

I'm writing in response to the application of 0 & 3454 Gillsville Highway. We have several concerns about the proposed 20-lot residential subdivision proposed by Sabina Chowdhury. The residents on Lebanon Church Road and community have private wells and do not have access to city water. Our concern is that the waste water could affect the private wells. There is a creek and lake on nearby property that could also be affected by the waste water from the proposed subdivision.

Another concern is the heavy traffic on Gillsville Highway and East Hall Road. Tadmore Elementary is approximately one-half mile from the entrance of the proposed subdivision. Traffic is heavy on East Hall Road and Gillsville Highway with buses traveling to Tadmore Elementary, East Hall Middle School, and East Hall High School. It is already difficult to pull out of East Hall Road onto Gillsville Highway because of the traffic. The entrance to the subdivision could be a very dangerous situation. Traffic flows around a blind curve and down a steep hill where the entrance would be. Traffic on Gillsville Highway is heavy with transfer trucks and other big trucks. When the trucks start down the hill they are traveling at a high rate of speed making it impossible for them to stop for vehicles turning into the subdivision or exiting. I'm writing in response to the rezoning and proposed subdivision at 0 & 3454 Gillsville Highway. The applicant is Sabina Chowdhury. I have several concerns about the request to rezone for a residential subdivision. This same applicant made the same proposal in 2020, and the request was denied by the commissioners. I don't understand why or how Sabina Chowdhury can request it again if it has already been denied.

I, Jacqueline Parks, owns the home at 3618 Lebanon Church Road. Our home was built in 1995. We have a private well. We do not have access to city water on Lebanon Church Road. I am concerned about a 20 plus lot subdivision, because I feel that the waste water will affect our private well. There is also a creek and a lake near the proposed subdivision that would also be affected by the waste water.

My other concern is the traffic on Gillsville Hwy. I travel on East Hall Road to commute to and from work every day. The traffic is very heavy because of buses traveling to Tadmore Elementary about one half mile from the proposed entrance to the subdivision. The buses also travel on East Hall Road to East Hall Middle School and East Hall High School. It is already difficult to pull out of East Hall Road on to Gillsville Hwy because of traffic. The entrance would only be about 370 feet from East Hall Road. The proposed entrance is very dangerous and a death trap for an entrance for a subdivision. There is a blind curve before traffic starts down the hill to the proposed entrance. Traffic is also very heavy with transfer trucks. When the trucks come around the curve and start down the hill they are traveling at a high rate of speed and it would be impossible for them to stop if someone pulled out in front of them or if a car stopped to turn into the subdivision. I fear that there would be several wrecks and lives could be lost.

Another concern is overcrowding of the schools. Tadmore Elementary was on the list of schools to be closed in the future. Overcrowding of the schools effects the students and teachers in a negative way. Low classroom numbers are needed for students to be successful. Where would the students attend school if Tadmore is closed in the future?

The backside of the proposed subdivision connects to a pasture and North Georgia Bee Farm. The other sides connect to single home residences.

There are property owners that live in this community that farm their land. There are farmers that plant large fields of corn here. They bale hay and raise cattle in nearby pastures. This community has a Plant Nursery and a pick your own local produce. North Georgia Bee Farm sells honey, Honey queen bees and Nucs.

Rezoning would not keep it consistant with the surrounding area. This community is "Single Home Residences". My husband, son, and I own our home at 3630 Lebanon Church Rd. We have lived here since 1981. We built our home in 1999. We have our own private well on our property. The neighbors also have their own private wells. Those that live here, on Lebanon Church Rd, do not have access to city water. We all have our own private wells on our property. I am concerned about the sewage from the proposed subdivision contaminating our private wells. We have no other access to water. There is also no sewage system in this area. There is a creek that flows across the whole backside of the proposed subdivision property. The creek continues down neighboring property and into a nearby lake. The creek continues along Lebanon Church Rd and Lebanon Campground Rd and flows into the Oconee river. I am concerned that the sewage could seep into our water system, contaminating our private wells, creeks, nearby lake and river. We need clean flowing streams to keep our environment safe and healthy. I am concerned with the storm water run off.I am down hill from the proposed subdivision.I am concerned with soil erosion on my property.

I am also concerned with traffic issues. Gillsville hwy is so busy ,its hard to enter and exit East Hall Rd.This highway is already a very busy, a high traffic, two lane highway.

Eighteen-wheelers are constantly traveling Gillsville hwy, you can hear them ,especially as they travel down that hill, day and night. The purposed entrance is on a hill as traffic flows around a blind curve. The hill is a blind spot on Gillsville hwy. On one side of the purposed subdivision entrance ,there is a bank that you would also have to look out from behind to pull out onto Gillsville hwy . Anyone entering or exiting the subdivision would cause a dangerous situation (a death trap) for anyone traveling Gillsville hwy. It would be impossible for an eighteen-wheeler to stop for anyone entering or exiting the subdivision. We have lots of buses entering and exiting East Hall Rd from Tadmore elementary, East Hall Middle and East Hall High School ,coming and going on Gillsville hwy.

I live on Lebanon Church Rd just a few feet down from East Hall Rd. We already get a lot of cut-through traffic from Gillsville hwy. Farming equipment travels from East Hall Rd down Gillsville hwy and through Lebanon Church Rd. to pastures nearby. This section of the roadway on Gillsville hwy. already has too much congestion all within a few feet of each other. The heavy flow of traffic coming from East Hall. Rd. ,Lebanon Church Rd and private residences adds to the heavy flow of traffic already on Gillsville hwy. I oppose the rezoning ,it is not consistent with the community or surrounding area. It is also a very dangerous purposed entrance on a very busy two lane highway. Please take all of this into consideration when you make your decision. Thank you for letting me share my concerns.

On January 19, 2021, the Hall County Board of Commissioners DENIED essentially the same proposal from Atlas Development, because of dangerous traffic issues.

The years later, this proposal resurfaced from Sabina Choudhury. Now, it faces even more serious traffic dangers, since traffic has continued to build up on both Gillsville Hwy and East Hall Rd.

VISIBILITY IS SEVERELY LIMITED BY THE BLIND CURVE & STEEP HILL.

I did an experiment every day for the past week, as I travelled east on Gillsville Hwy at the posted speed limit (55 mph).

- 1) After entering the curve and beginning the steep descent on the hill, I waited until I could SEE the re-zoning sign at the proposed location.
- Then I counted the seconds until I REACHED the sign.
- 3) The difference was only 3 seconds.

I was horrified to realize that – if the rezoning sign were a car pulling out of the subdivision entrance – I might not be able to stop in time to avoid hitting it!

Subdivision residents pulling out of the entrance could be in the worst danger, because they are moving slowly, and they can't see the 55-mph traffic coming at them, from over the hill, until it's practically right on top of them.

GILLSVILLE HWY AND EAST HALL RD INTERSECTION IS ALREADY DANGEROUS. Adding subdivision entering/departing traffic could make it even more dangerous.

BOTTOM LINE: The proposed 3454 Gillsville Hwy location has multiple dangerous factors -- blind curve, steep hill, already-dangerous intersection, and heavy schoolbus and truck traffic.

Please deny this proposal, for sake of saving lives.

There is also a business entrance across the road from the trailer park. The business has lots of large trucks and equipment entering the highway. There have been other accidents here. This road is dangerous and this is a high traffic area already.

We had to be a certain distance from neighboring property lines for everything we did on our property. The subdivision isn't consistent with our community and neighboring properties its connected to. The creek that flows on the backside of the proposed subdivision property concerns me.It flows into nearby streams and a lake.I am concerned about the safety of our well water on our property and neighboring properties. The subdivision will be sitting on a hill. Two sides slope onto neighboring properties. One side slopes down and connects to the back of my property. I am concerned about all those septic tanks contaminating our water system. Our wells are our only access to water here on Lebanon Church Road. The homes nearby on Gillsville Hwy which are older homes also have their own wells on their property. I am also concerned about storm water and erosion on my property. The proposed subdivision property slopes downhill and connects to the backside of my property. I would also like to know what the plans are for a piece of the property that connects to the back of my property. Another concern is the entrance on Gillsville Hwy. I have lived in this community all my life and I know how dangerous this section of the road is. There are steep hills and holes on both sides of the highway. There is no where to go if there is an emergency and you needed to get out of the way. There are private driveways across from East Hall Rd entering and exiting the hwy.
