Approval and authorization for the Chairman to execute a resolution containing amendments to the Animal Control Ordinance, and any and all documents necessary to effectuate such amendments, subject to review and approval by the County Attorney.

History:
The last major revision to the Animal Control Ordinance occurred in 2023, and the proposed revisions reflect changes based upon Hall County's experience with Animal Control issues.

Facts and Issues:
The proposed revisions include enacting the "Public Nuisance Animal" definition into an enforceable code section. The revisions also address mandatory microchipping for dogs and cats reclaimed at the Animal Shelter, providing a more efficient service for the residents of Hall County, as well as greater pet/owner retention.
