


General Fund FY 2025 Budget to Actual





Emergency Services Fund FY 2025 Budget to Actual










E911 Fund FY 2025 Budget to Actual

FY 2025 Budget Reconciliation Highlights

- Reduction of \$ 4.63 million in overall county budget
- The use of \$ 322 thousand of Contingency was strategically planned to fund critical services and still have funds available.
- Capital Projects adjustments and cash flow true-ups
 - Reduced cash flow for completed roof replacements in SPLOST VIII
 - Significant reduction in SPLOST VII cash flow for the Mulberry Creek project
 - Adjustment in the solid waste fund for the cash flow needed for the Leachate Plant Upgrades and Allen Creek Permitting Project.
- Reallocation of existing vacant positions to cover new additions and not increase the overall position count. Positions being recommended for addition:
 - One Deputy Clerk Probate Court
 - Three Seasonal PT Intern Clerk of Court



FY 2025 Budget Reconciliation Highlights

- The Grant and Restricted Fund increase primarily due to:
 - Adjusting cash flows for the EDA and GTIB Grants related to White Sulphur Road Realignment
 - Restricted Funds increased, primarily, due to increases in activity of approved uses for these funds that are held in trust by the County.
