Hall County Fire Marshal's Comments:

- 1) Minimum 8 inch underground fire line with fire hydrants under pressure are required to be installed throughout the development where required by fire code.
- 2) Fire apparatus access roads are required by code to be no less than 20' wide.
- 3) The day use facilities because of size, use and occupant load will be required by code to have a supervised fire protection system designed, installed, tested, and certified to NFPA 13 standards.
- 4) The day use facilities because of size, use and occupant load will be required by code to have a supervised fire alarm system designed, installed, tested, and certified to NFPA 72 standards.
- 5) Any day use facility over 12,000 SF will be required by code to have an emergency responder radio communication system test completed, any building failing the test will be required to have a bidirectional antenna system for emergency radio communication installed.
- 6) All over night accommodations are considered by code to be lodging and are required to have a supervised fire protection and fire alarm system installed throughout.
- 7) The plans are conceptual in nature and if approved may require modifications during the development review process.
