Item 1A/B: 2811 Athens Hwy, Dunagan: Must meet all Environmental Health commercial septic system permitting requirements. Further determination will be made during the civil plan review process. A detailed business plan must be submitted to Hall County Environmental Health for review. Additional items, including, but not limited to: recorded plat, soil evaluation, and septic system installation may be required after review of business plan.

Item 2, 0/2010 Candler Rd, Dunagan: All proposed lots must meet Hall County Board of Health Lot Size Resolution requirements. Please note that Zoning approval does not imply approval from other county departments. Further determination will be made during the plat review process.

Item 3, 3384 Lee Drive, Muntean: All proposed structures must meet all residential permitting requirements and/or required setbacks to existing septic system. An existing system evaluation/site visit will be required for Environmental Health to process the building permit application. Please note that Zoning approval does not imply approval from other county departments.

Item 4, 5444 Oak Manor Way, PHD Developments, LLC: No comment.

Item 5A/B, 5709 McEver Rd, Moosa: Must meet all Environmental Health commercial septic system permitting requirements if sewer is not available to the property. Further determination will be made during the civil plan review process. A detailed business plan must be submitted to Hall County Environmental Health for review.

Item 6, 3219 Lake Drive, A&R Engineering: All proposed lots must meet Hall County Board of Health Lot Size Resolution requirements. Please note that Zoning approval does not imply approval from other county departments. Further determination will be made during the plat review process.
