The request before you is from Clean Eagle RNG, LLC to rezone from Agricultural Residential (AR-IV) and Highway Business (H-B) to Planned Industrial Development (PID) for a natural gas facility. This item is located within Commission District 3.

At the Board of Commissioners meeting on March 27, 2025, the board **voted to table** the request to the **April 8, 2025 Board of Commissioners meeting**.

On February 10, 2025 the applicant **requested to table** from the February 27, 2025 to the **March 27, 2025** meeting.

At their January 21, 2025 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend denial (4-0, Sosebee absent).

Staff recommendation: **Denial,** as the proposed use is inconsistent with the future land use designation of "Rural Scenic Nodes and Corridors" in the Comprehensive Plan.
