### **Purpose of Request:**

Approve the modification of Taylor Ewing's appointment to the Library Board to correct her term end date to June 30, 2027. Commission District 1.

#### Facts and Issues:

Taylor Ewing has served two full terms on the Libary Board.

In an effort to stagger the Library Board's appointments, there is a provision within their by-laws that a member may serve an extended term which states, "No member shall serve more than two consecutive three-year terms unless more than three board members are rotating off the board at one time. In that instance, volunteers may be solicited to serve an additional term of 1-2 years to ensure staggered terms are maintained. These names will be submitted to their appointing Commissioner for potential re-appointment."
