



This proposal outlines the comprehensive plan to cover the necessary classes, books, and fees for completing the EMT (Emergency Medical Technician) and AEMT (Advanced Emergency Medical Technician) diploma programs at Lanier Technical College. These programs will provide students with the knowledge and skills to obtain both the Emergency Medical Technician Certificate and Advanced Emergency Medical Technician Certificate.

Upon completion of these programs, students will be eligible to challenge the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) exam for EMT certification and the NREMT-A exam for AEMT certification. It is important to note that students **must** pass the NREMT exam before they are eligible to challenge the NREMT-A exam. NOTE: Any student that has not been successful in challenging the NREMT exams within 2 years or are unsuccessful in 6 attempts will have to retake the program.

This proposal includes the following components:

1. **Class Enrollment:** The student will be enrolled in the required courses for both EMT and AEMT certifications, covering foundational and advanced emergency medical procedures, patient assessment, trauma care, and medical emergencies.
2. **Books and Materials:** All necessary textbooks, study materials, and other resources required for the EMT and AEMT programs will be provided or covered under the proposal.
3. **Fees:** The proposal will cover the tuition, testing fees, and any other required fees for both the EMT and AEMT programs, including fees for the NREMT and NREMT-A exams.
4. **Credentialing Exam Preparation:** Students will receive the necessary training and preparation to challenge both the NREMT and NREMT-A exams, ensuring they meet the

1. Be a high school graduate or obtain GED.
2. Have applied for admission to Lanier Technical College.
3. Have taken the ACCUPLACER/COMPASS/ASSET exams as required for admission to Lanier Technical College.
4. Be current employee of Hall County Fire Rescue.
