Highlights

- The FY 2026 budget will reflect an overall neutral change when compared to FY 2025
- Total positions: 1,863 (full time equivalents)
 - New positions for FY 2025: 10 (full time equivalents)
- Compensation and Benefits
 - Mid-year compensation adjustment with Cost-of-Living (COLA), longevity and merit factors (i.e. performance basis)
 - Base retirement match increase
- Capital Investment
 - FY 2026 Capital Budget: \$ 100.3 million
 - 5 Year Capital Improvement Plan: \$ 697.4 million




Capital Improvement Plan

- White Sulphur and Highway 365 Road Improvements
- Design and Right-of-way acquisition for Spout Springs Road Phase II
- Construction of Lights Ferry and McEver Road Round-a-bout
- Construction of new East Hall Library
- Sheriff's Office Gun Range Improvements
- Candler Road Landfill Improvements
- Design of South Hall Park and Active Life Center
- Continued investment in vehicles and equipment






Expenditures by Function
