Purpose of Request:

Approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Hall County and the Georgia Department of Public Safety for the use of certain talk groups on the Hall County Public Safety Radio System, subject to review and approval by the County Attorney.

History:

Currently, Hall County law enforcement agencies are only able to communicate with the Georgia State Patrol through relaying information between the county's dispatch center and the GSP dispatch center. Some GSP officers do carry an additional radio in their vehicle that can communicate directly between officers, however that method is inefficient.

Facts and Issues:

This IGA will allow Hall County 911 and law enforcement agencies the ability to directly communicate with the Georgia State Patrol officers, and vice versa, through a patch between the Hall County Radio System and the State of Georgia's LTE radio system.

Options:

This is a no cost solution for Hall County that provides a safer and reliable means for officers and dispatchers to communicate during emergencies and non-emergency events. This is also a state-wide effort in which other jurisdictions are entering into the same agreement for more efficient communication methods.
