This letter serves as a formal statement of intent to request the rezoning of the property located at 2620 & 2634 Barrett Road, Gainesville, GA 30507, with parcel numbers 15023A000007 & 15023A000037. The properties encompass approximately 4.42 acres and are currently zoned as Light Industrial (I-1). The request is to rezone the property to Heavy Industrial (I-2) to support the proposed development of a food packaging and handling facility. The subject properties currently have warehouses used for staffing solutions for poultry companies. The property is positioned to support the proposed rezoning request due to the change of business that will be conducted in the warehouses, from staffing solutions to food handling and packaging.

The request to rezone the property to Heavy Industrial (I-2) is justified by several factors. The proposed development aligns with Hall County's Comprehensive Plan, which designates this area for industrial use. The transition to I-2 zoning supports the plan's objectives to promote industrial growth in appropriate areas, fostering economic development. The property's location and existing infrastructure make it well-suited for the intended food packaging and handling operations.
