Hall County Fire Marshal's Comments

- 1. The proposed 12,000 SF building location is greater than the 500-foot hose lay distance requirement from the nearest fire hydrant. If approved an 8-inch water main and fire hydrant will have to be installed to meet the 500-foot hose lay distance requirement from the fire hydrant to the building.
- 2. The Hall County Fire Marshal's Office considers the plan conceptual in nature and if approved may require modifications during the development review process.
- 3. The use of the proposed 12,000 SF building has not been identified in the narrative report. Depending on the use additional life safety requirements could be required.
