The request before you is the appeal of Vital Foods, LLC, Juan Carlos Lomas, c/o Gaskins + LeCraw of the September 2, 2025, Planning Commission decision to deny the variance request to reduce the number of parking spaces required for outdoor recreation. This item is located within Commission District 4.

At their September 2, 2025 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to deny the request (3-1, Davidson opposed and Hunt absent).

Staff recommendation: **Denial,** as no hardship exists pursuant to the criteria of 11.1.1.D.11 which required the number of parking spaces for this application to be 58 spaces.

There were no comments submitted in advance of the Planning Commission meeting, and no one spoke in opposition during the public hearing.

Had the Planning Commission not been appealed, their decision would have been the final action.

- **Approving** the appeal **overturns** the Planning Commission decision and **approves** the reduction in the number of parking spaces required.
- Denying the appeal upholds the Planning Commission decision and denies the reduction in the number of parking spaces required.
