Hall County, Georgia Sheriff's Office is issuing this Task Order #2026-022 to Demand Services On-Call Public Works Contractors to reorientate and improve the Sheriff's Firing Range located at 2684 Allen Creek Rd, Gainesville, GA 30507.

Bid Response: Complete the information below and return it to the Issuing Officer via email, by the date and time specified above. Electronic signatures are acceptable.

Taxes: The County is exempt from State of Georgia Local Sales and Use Tax. The Bidder understands and acknowledges that it is responsible for any sales and use taxes it may incur. The Bidder will not charge or invoice the County any sales and use tax as a separate line item. The Contractor may request a copy of the County's Georgia Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate.

Bonds: Not required for this solicitation.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Please refer to the attached illustrations.

The Hall County Sheriff's Firing Range is presently orientated for live fire exercises for live ammunition to impact an earthen berm located on the southwest boundary of the firing range. The Sheriff's Office desires to reorientate the firing range for live ammunition to impact the southeast boundary of the firing range.

The awarded contractor will be responsible for all utility locates and field verifying dimensions.

- Remove and dispose of existing block wall that bisects the firing range. (Refer to black Xs on the attached illustration.)
- Relocate existing covered structures on the northeast boundary of the firing range to the northwest boundary of the firing range. (Refer to red lines on attached illustration.)
- Furnish and install precast concrete bin blocks measuring 2' x 2' x 6' along the northeastern boundary of the firing range.
 - Overall height of bin blocks shall be equal to the height of the existing bisecting block wall, approximately 12'.
 - o Overall length of bin blocks shall be 75 yards at a minimum.
 - o Awarded contractor is responsible for field verifying wall dimensions.
- Furnish and install precast concrete bin blocks measuring 2' x 2' x 6' in the middle of the range, parallel to the newly installed block wall along the northeastern boundary of the range. This center wall will bisect the firing range thus creating two firing ranges.
 - Overall height of bin blocks shall be equal to the height of the existing bisecting block wall, approximately 12'.
 - Overall length of bin blocks shall be 75 yards at a minimum.
 - o Awarded contractor is responsible for field verifying wall dimensions.
- Relocate targets from existing berm on the southwest boundary to new berm on the southeast boundary.

New Berm

- Remove and dispose of existing light fixture along the southeast boundary of the firing range.
 - Cap and abandon electrical conduit.
- Furnish and install earthen materials to construct a new berm along the southeast boundary of the firing range. (Refer to green line on attached illustration.)
 - o Furnish and install proper vegetation and/or pervious materials to control erosion and prevent stormwater runoff from the newly constructed berm.
 - Hall County will relocate targets.

Option 1

- Remove and dispose of rock from bisected area of firing range. (Refer to black Xs on the attached illustration.)
- Furnish and install sod.

Option 2

• Furnish and install concrete pad spanning the length of the bisected area of the firing range.

• The awarded contractor shall use his/her discretion regarding the removal and disposal of existing rock.

Option 3

• Clear scrub vegetation and trim trees around sniper target area.

^{**} Excluding weather delays. Bin Blocks could push out to 25 weeks from NTP due to fabrication / procurement time.

^{*} Earthwork price includes: Earthwork, import dirt, french drain, general conditions, and WALL ALONG THE REAR OF THE BERM. Berm cannot be constructed within space provided without inclusion of this wall. The berm as drawn on the plans with 1.25:1 slopes above the wall and wall height suggested on plans can't be realistically constructed. We have included in our price a taller structural wall along with adjusted berm slope to a more constructible gradient.
