**Purpose of Request:** Approval and authorization for the Chairman to execute a resolution authorizing the application of the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Local Administered Projects Certification to administer federal-aid projects; authorization for the Chairman to execute any and all documents required to effectuate this application and certification, subject to review and approval by the County Attorney.

**History:** Hall County was a Certified LAP in prior years. Certification lapsed in 2020; therefore, a new certification is required to administer federal-aid projects.  
Hall County BOC has adopted and executed the required GDOT Procurement Policy and Title VI Agreement with Assurances in February 2026 and is included in this application.

#### Facts and Issues:

#### Options:

Georgia Department of Transportation has developed a Local Administered Projects Certification process to ensure the resource capacity and ability of the Local Public Agency to successfully manage, administer, and execute the policies and procedures for Federal and state compliance in order to receive Federal-aid funding participation for transportation projects. If approved, Hall County will remain a GDOT LAP for 5 years until renewal is due.

GDOT serves as the prime recipient of federal transportation funds. In accordance with 23 Code of Federal Regulation Part 635.105, GDOT is the supervising agency; as such, it is responsible for authorizing performance of the work by Local Agencies on all Federal-aid projects. Hall County would be a recipient of federal funds through GDOT to administer deferrally funded projects.
